**Secondary Education Certificate (SEC), Intermediate (IM)  
and Advanced Level (AM)**

**ATTN: Candidates sitting for Art at SEC, IM and AM level**

**Candidates sitting for Art at Secondary Education Certificate (SEC) Level:**

- Candidates sitting for ART at (SEC) level are to submit in their own one (1) folder the coursework and final project.
- Private candidates sitting for Art at SEC level are to submit their coursework and final project in ONE official folder provided by the MATSEC Support Unit (University of Malta).
- Candidates (irrelevant whether private or not) should avoid tempering the folders. The Coursework and Project would NOT be accepted by the MATSEC Support Unit if the folders are tempered.
- In case of private candidates the MATSEC Support Unit (University of Malta) would not accept works if not in the appropriate official folders provided by MATSEC Support Unit (University of Malta).
- Candidates (irrelevant whether private or not) are not to present the Coursework and Project if these are larger than the size of the folder. Excessive mounting should be avoided. Size of sheets of paper is indicated clearly on the syllabus.

**Candidates sitting for Art at Intermediate (IM) and Advanced (AM) Level:**

- Coursework and the Final Project for Intermediate (IM) and Advanced level (AM) are to be placed in separate official folders provided by MATSEC Support Unit (University of Malta).
- The IM and AM Coursework and Project would NOT be accepted by the MATSEC Support Unit if not presented in the appropriate official folders provided by MATSEC Support Unit (University of Malta).
- Candidates are to avoid tempering the folders. The folders would NOT be accepted by the MATSEC Support Unit if these are tempered.
- Candidates are not to present the Coursework and Project if these are larger than the size of the folders. Excessive mounting should be avoided. Size of sheets of paper is indicated clearly on the syllabus.
- If a piece of sculpture is presented as Coursework and Project, this has to be packed properly according to sizes indicated in the syllabi.

**Note:**

- In the examination session candidates who use their own sheets of paper instead of those provided by MATSEC for the examinations to draw/sketch on are reminded to exactly abide to the size indicated in the syllabus.
