If there are more qualified applicants than 2 (the number of places offered), a rank order will be established through an interview process. All qualified applicants will be asked to attend an interview.

Criteria for selection will be based as follows:

•	First degree in Fine Arts plus P.G.C.E.	
•	Degree classification	
•	Grade obtained in dissertation in first degree	
•	Any additional courses including research methods	
Teaching Experience		20%
•	Years of teaching experience (Art Teaching Portfolio to be	
	presented)	
Art Practice		20%
•	Art Practice Portfolio to be presented. The portfolio should	
	show evidence of sustained enquiry in visual arts practice,	
	in particular, contemporary artistic studies that the	
	applicant him/herself has undertaken.	
Interview		20%
•	During the interview applicants will be asked to:	
	 explain their reasons for applying for this course 	
	talk about their proposal	
	• demonstrate the extent and nature of engagement in	
	the selected topic and art practice.
