The University of Malta (UoM) recognises the importance of Student Exchange Programmes. Every academic year full-time registered students of the University of Malta may apply to participate in the Students' International Exchange Programmes.

Students accepted to participate in these exchange programmes are exempted from paying tuition fees to the host institution and are awarded grants in cash or in kind depending on the type of bilateral agreements with the Universities

The four students who are selected to study at Victoria University (VU) in Melbourne, Australia, have an excellent opportunity of being awarded a scholarship of AUS\$5000 (approximately: €3,700) each, from the Australian Government while they are at VU. Students applying to study at VU will be required to submit a separate application as provided by the International & EU Office.

The deadline for the submission of the applications is at **noon on Friday, 25th November 2011**. Late applications will not be accepted.

As a general rule students who will be in their final year during the academic year 2011/12 cannot be nominated for an exchange programme.
