

This guide assists University of Malta & Junior College users to set up eduroam on their Android 4.x (KitKat) devices to connect to the wireless network at UoM/JC and at other institutions participating in the eduroam initiative.

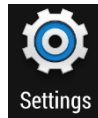

Note that:

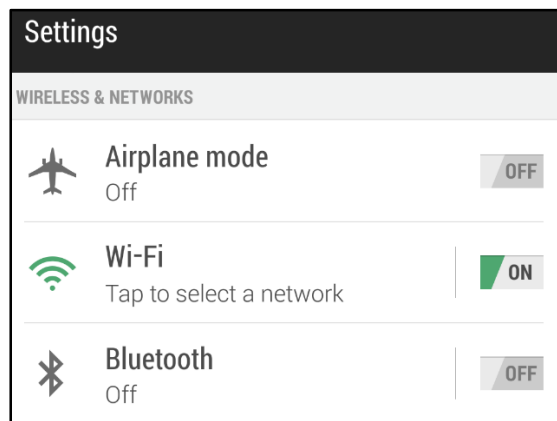
- Your Android device may require that you enter a pass code before you configure it to connect to eduroam.
- Your screen may vary slightly from the screenshots depending on the mobile phone brand and software edition.

To set up eduroam:

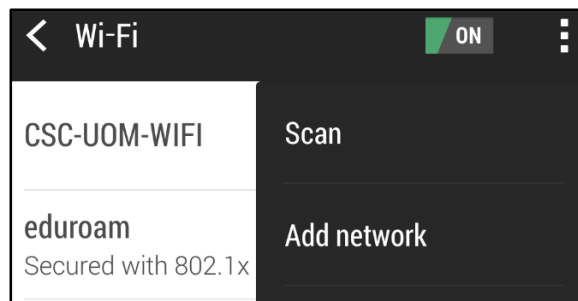
1. In the app drawer, tap **Settings**.



2. The settings screen is displayed. Ensure that **Wi-Fi** is **ON** and tap **Wi-Fi**.



3. A list of available wireless networks is displayed. Tap the **Three Vertical Dots** generally found at the top-right corner for more options, then tap **Add network**.



- In the Add Network screen, set the network properties as indicated below:

Network SSID: eduroam

Security: 802.1x EAP

EAP method: TTLS

Phase2 authentication: PAP

Identity: University/Junior College email address

e.g. john.borg@um.edu.mt, jbor0001@jc.um.edu.mt

Password: Your corresponding University or Junior College email password
