- January's Progress report consists of a one (1) to two (2) pages report, illustration any changes in direction and/or work done on prior Panel of Supervision feedback.

Panel of Supervision to give their Statement on the progress report. Everything is submitted to the Board of Studies for consideration and monitoring.

Monday 3rd April 2023:

- Final opportunity for students to submit requests for changes in MSc dissertation titles. All requests for changes in dissertation titles need to be accompanied by a recommendation of the supervisor(s), prior to submission to departmental offices.
 - Requests must be submitted by 12:00pm and no further changes in titles will be approved after this date.
- Students should have already started to submit first drafts of their dissertation chapters directly to their respective supervisors for feedback and corrections. Arrangements for the submission of these drafts are to be handled and arranged between the supervisor and the student.

Monday 10th April 2023:

Peedback by Supervisor(s) on First Draft.

Friday 5th May 2023:

Students to submit an electronic copy of their dissertation. This is to be uploaded on the university google drive and shared with Ms Gianuaria Crugliano (gianuaria.crugliano@um.edu.mt).

The oral presentation will be composed of:

- Students will be requested to start the viva by taking up to 5 minutes to summarise their work to the examiners. During this time, students may show a demo, but are requested not to use slides.
- An interactive question and answer session with the Board of Examiners to discuss in more detail the work of the student, not lasting more than 30 minutes maximum

Friday 15th September 2023

Submission of Hard Bound Copies:

Students are to submit two hard bound copies of the dissertation to the Faculty (Three hard bound copies in case there is also co-supervision), and one electronic version for the University Library (which shall include a signed declaration of authenticity) need to be submitted. The electronic version must conform to the standards set by the University of Malta Library.

Before producing the Hard Bound copies, through their respective supervisor(s), students are asked to ensure that there are no nominal changes proposed by the Board of Examiners.

Submissions are to be carried out STRICTLY BY NOON to Ms Gianuaria Crugliano (Room 3, Level 1, Block B, ICT Building).
