Paper I is the Literature Core Paper, and the students were examined on the *Iphigenia in Aulis* by Euripides and the *Hellenica* by Xenophon. Six questions were set for each author, and were intended to examine the students' knowledge of the set works, as well as their knowledge of the Greek language.

Paper II consisted of a translation, comprehension, and a choice between a more difficult translation into English, and a translation of sentences into Greek.
