Criteria for Selection for the Master of Social Work Course
Intake: October 2018

Degree Type and Classification

Total Weighting = 30 points (30%)

- First Class (Hons) = 30 points
- Second Class (Hons) Upper Division = 20 points
- Category I = 20 points
- Category IIA = 10 points

Social-Care related Experience

Requirement:

Applicants must present reflections on social-care related experience which they would have engaged in not less than three years prior to the commencement of the Course.

Total Weighting of reflections = 15 points (15%)

- Excellent = 15 points
- Very good = 13 points
- Good = 10 points
- Average = 7 points

Professional Aptitude and Disposition

Requirement:

Applicants who obtain less than 60% for the professional aptitude and disposition criterion shall automatically not be admitted into the Course.

Total Weighting = 50 points (50%)

- Individual interview = 25 points (25%)
- Group Interview = 20 points (20%)

- Other post-graduate qualification in a relevant area of study = 5 points (5%)
Post-graduate degree = 5 points
Post-graduate Diploma = 3 points
Post-graduate Certificate = 2 points

- Highly recommended= 5 points
- Recommended = 3 points
