



ELECTION OF ONE FACULTY REPRESENTATIVE ON SENATE

In terms of Article 78(d) and Article 83 (1) of the Education Act, (Cap 327), an electronic election by and from among the academic staff of the Faculty of Information & Communication Technology was held on **Wednesday, 2nd March 2016**, to elect one faculty representative to sit on Senate for a period of two years.

Out of **39** ballots cast by electronic secret ballot, the following result was obtained:
