



Brendan Donnelly has been the Director of the think tank The Federal Trust since January 2003, and until 2010 was also Chairman of the pro-European organisation Federal Union. In 1994 he was elected as the Conservative Member of the European Parliament for Sussex South and Crawley (1994 to 1999). He subsequently left the Conservative Party and continued as an independent politician until he co-founded the Pro-European Conservative Party, for which he stood as deputy chairman in the 1999 elections. In the 2009 European elections he stood under the Yes2Europe political label, and in the 2014 European elections for the 4 Freedoms Party (UK EPP).

Previous to his political career he had worked as an official in the British Foreign Office, the European Parliament and in the European Commission, for European Commissioner Lord Cockfield.

Mr Donnelly was educated at Oxford, where he obtained a double first in classics. He is the author of "On the Edge: Britain and Europe" (jointly with Hugh Dykes; 2012) and numerous articles on the European Union, on Britain's place in the European Union and on federalism.
