The commencement of any course is subject to availability of resources at the time of opening and other factors beyond the University's control.

The University's academic year is divided in two semesters: the first semester runs from October to January, whilst the second semester runs from February to May. Some postgraduate courses may include a summer semester (June to September).

The University also offers doctoral degrees (Doctor of Philosophy, Doctor of Music, and Doctor of Sacred Theology) on a full-time or part-time basis for which applications are received at any time of the year. Tuition, annual enrolment, and bench fees may be payable, including for part-time courses.
