2. The main duties and responsibilities of the appointee will consist of carrying out Research and Project Management Assistant duties including:
 - a. Produce deliverables within the stipulated time frames as specified in the project description;
 - b. Develop an online, responsive (web) portal application;
 - c. Test the web application;
 - d. Liaise with front-end designers;
 - e. Use of modern software development methodologies, frameworks and tools; such as agile, git, etc.
 - f. Use of open-source CMS software (Wordpress)
 - g. Document software (user and technical manuals);
 - h. Writing reports and academic papers; and
 - i. Perform any other project related task as instructed by the project coordinators.
3. The appointee is expected to work at such places and during such hours as may be determined by the University authorities.
4. The selection procedure will involve:
 - a. scrutiny of qualifications and experience claimed and supported by testimonials and/or certificates (copies to be included with the application); and
 - b. an interview and / or extended interview.
