NUR5130	Emergency Trauma Care (Semester 2)	10 ECTS Credits
<p>Available for: Qualified nurses who hold a registration as a first level nurse with the Council for Nurses and Midwives or a regulatory body recognised by the UM; in possession of at least a level 6 qualification in nursing / health science, currently working in an area of emergency / critical / acute care. NUR5131	Advanced Nursing Management of Critically Ill Patients (Semester 2)	10 ECTS Credits
<p>This study-unit is primarily intended for qualified nurses who work in critical care areas and who are expected to assess, manage and care for critically ill patients and their relatives.</p> <p>Available for: Qualified nurses with a minimum of an EQF level 6 qualification and who hold a registration as a first level nurse with the Council for Nurses and Midwives or a regulatory body recognised by the UM. Interested applicants who are not in possession of a level 6 qualification in nursing / health science are encouraged to contact the study-unit coordinator / CPD courses administrator. Limited to 20 students.</p> <p>CPD study-unit fee: €400</p>		

Available for: Qualified nurses with a minimum of an EQF level 6 qualification and who hold a registration as a first level nurse with the Council for Nurses and Midwives or a regulatory body recognised by the UM. Interested applicants who are not in possession of a level 6 qualification in nursing / health science are encouraged to contact the study-unit coordinator / CPD courses administrator.

Limited to 15 students.

CPD study-unit fee: €400

Practising health care professionals who are interested in enrolling on these study-units are invited to apply between **Monday 24 October and Friday 28 October**. **Further details on how to apply will be communicated in due course.**

All applications will be considered on a first come first served basis. Applicants can apply for not more than 30 ECTS credits per semester.
