



MEP Roberta Metsola [EPP, MT] was elected to the European Parliament in 2013, becoming one of Malta's first female Members of the European Parliament. Professionally she is a lawyer who has specialised in European law and politics. She has previously worked at the Permanent Representation of Malta to the European Union and as legal advisor to the High Representative of the European Union for Foreign Affairs and Security Policy. MEP Roberta Metsola is the EPP Vice-Coordinator of the Committee on Civil Liberties, Justice and Home Affairs (LIBE), where she is the lead MEP on migration issues. MEP Roberta Metsola is also the co-rapporteur on the situation in the Mediterranean and the need for a holistic EU approach to migration. MEP Roberta Metsola is also the Vice-Chair of the European Parliament Committee on Petitions (PETI) and a member of the Delegation for relations with the United States (D-US). She is also a substitute member of the Committee on the Internal Market and Consumer Protection (IMCO) and the Delegation for relations with Australia and New Zealand (DANZ).
