In accordance with Regulation 29, the term of office is of one year. At present there are vacancies for two student representatives on the Board of Studies for Psychology (Bachelor of Arts).

Nominations are to be duly proposed and seconded by enrolled students. Nominated students are required to signify, in writing, acceptance of their nomination.


Nominations will be published on the Faculty of Arts and the Psychology notice-boards on **Tuesday, 24th October, 2017**.
