**ELECTION OF THREE STUDENT REPRESENTATIVES ON THE BOARD OF THE  
INTERNATIONAL SCHOOL FOR FOUNDATION STUDIES**

**TO ALL STUDENTS**

In terms of Article 5(x) of the Statute of the International School for Foundation Studies, **three members, one from each programme, are elected by and from among the students of the School.** In accordance with Article 83(1) of the Education Act the term of office shall be for two years.

There are **three** vacancies on the Board of the **International School for Foundation Studies**, one student from each programme, and the term of office shall extend from 10<sup>th</sup> November 2017 till 9<sup>th</sup> November 2019.

Nominations, on forms available from the University of Malta website ([www.um.edu.mt/studentrepresentatives](http://www.um.edu.mt/studentrepresentatives)), are to be handed in at the **Office of the Registrar (Room 209), Administration Building** by not later than **noon of Wednesday 25<sup>th</sup> October 2017.**

Nominations are to be duly proposed and seconded by enrolled students. Nominated students are required to signify, in writing, acceptance of their nomination.

Nominations received will be published on the University of Malta website on **Friday 27<sup>th</sup> October, 2017** and all students will be informed of this by email.

**Eligibility to vote:** All students enrolled during the current academic year.

Voting for these elections will take place on **Thursday, 9<sup>th</sup> November 2017** between **09.00am and 6.00pm.**

An **ONLINE** election system will be used. On the day of the election, you will receive an e-mail on your University e-mail account with a link to vote. You can only vote once and your voting choices will remain anonymous.
