



Call for Applications
Scholarship for Masters Of Science (Research) Student
Cancer Immunotherapy Project 2017 to 2018
Department of Anatomy
Faculty of Medicine & Surgery

1. Applications are invited for a scholarship for a Master of Science student to work on a project to study therapeutic options of immunotherapy for Cancer. The scholarship funded by the non-profit organisation, ALIVE Charity Foundation, facilitated by the Research Trust (RIDT) of the University of Malta. The project is coordinated by the University of Malta under the supervision of Dr Pierre Schembri-Wismayer (Department of Anatomy).
2. Applicants must be in possession of a good first degree in a biological subject and be eligible for Master's studies. Familiarity with biochemical research methods, previous experience with immunohistochemistry, flow cytometry, in vivo model systems and cell culturing will be considered as an asset.
3. This scholarship shall provide a stipend of 6000 p.a. for the full-time Master's student and covers a period of eighteen months. The scholarship shall also provide a total of €2000 to cover costs for exchange visits to collaborators, €8000 as a bursary to cover University Bench Fees, and €1,000 to cover publications and attending conferences.
4. The selected candidate is expected to enrol in the University of Malta's Master of Science (Molecular and Cell Biology) at the Faculty of Medicine and Surgery and conduct research in cancer over a period of 18 months. The Scholarship is for a maximum period of 18 months, which will be subject to the eligibility of the candidate to enrol in the Masters programme.
5. Candidates should submit their letter of application, copy of their curriculum vitae, and one set of copies of their certificates to projects.hrmd@um.edu.mt by not later than noon of Monday 13th February 2017.

Late applications will not be considered.
