



## ELECTION OF ONE FACULTY REPRESENTATIVE ON SENATE

### TO ACADEMIC STAFF MEMBERS:

- FACULTY OF INFORMATION & COMMUNICATION TECHNOLOGY
- FACULTY OF SCIENCE

According to the provisions of the Education Act (Cap 327), Article 78(d) the Senate includes a representative of each faculty elected by and from among the academic staff of that faculty. In accordance with Article 83(1) the term of office shall be for a period of two years.

Nominations on forms available from the office of Human Resources Management and Development, Room 215, Administration Building, are to be handed in at the **Rector's Office**, by **noon of Monday, 22<sup>nd</sup> February 2016**.

Nominations are to be duly proposed and seconded by academic members of the faculty. Nominated candidates have to signify in writing acceptance of their nomination.

Nominations will be published on the Faculty Notice Board and the Main Notice Board (Administration Building) on **Monday, 22<sup>nd</sup> February 2016**.

For this purpose, and if necessary, an electronic election will be held on **Wednesday, 2<sup>nd</sup> March 2016** from **9.00a.m. to 9.00p.m.**

Voting rights for Council appointed Resident Academic and Visiting Teaching Staff will be in accordance with Appendix C of the Collective Agreement for Academic Staff of the University of Malta and Academic Staff of the Junior College 2014-2018.

Eligible voters must have a UoM IT Account.
