

This guide assists University of Malta & Junior College users to set up eduroam on their Android 5.x (Lollipop), Android 6.x (Marshmallow) & Android 7.x (Nougat) devices to connect to the wireless network at UoM/JC and at other institutions participating in the eduroam initiative.

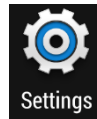

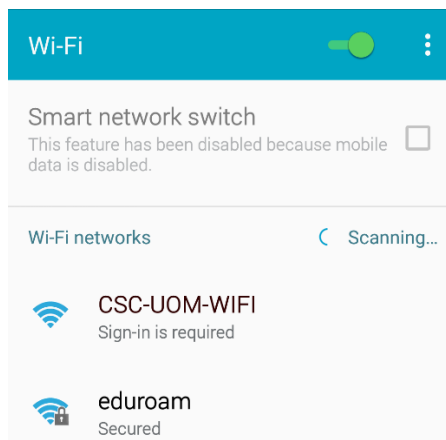
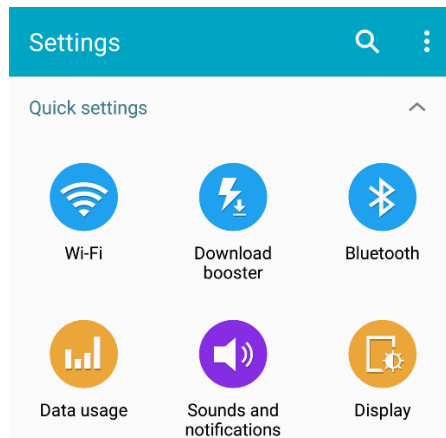
- Your Android device may require that you enter a pass code before you configure it to connect to eduroam.
- Your screen may vary slightly from the screenshots depending on the mobile phone brand and software edition.

To set up eduroam:

1. In the app drawer, tap **Settings**.



2. The settings screen is displayed. Tap on Wi-Fi and ensure that **Wi-Fi** is **ON**.



- A list of available wireless networks is displayed. Tap on eduroam and set the network properties as indicated below:

**Network SSID:** eduroam

**EAP method:** TTLS

**Phase2 authentication:** PAP

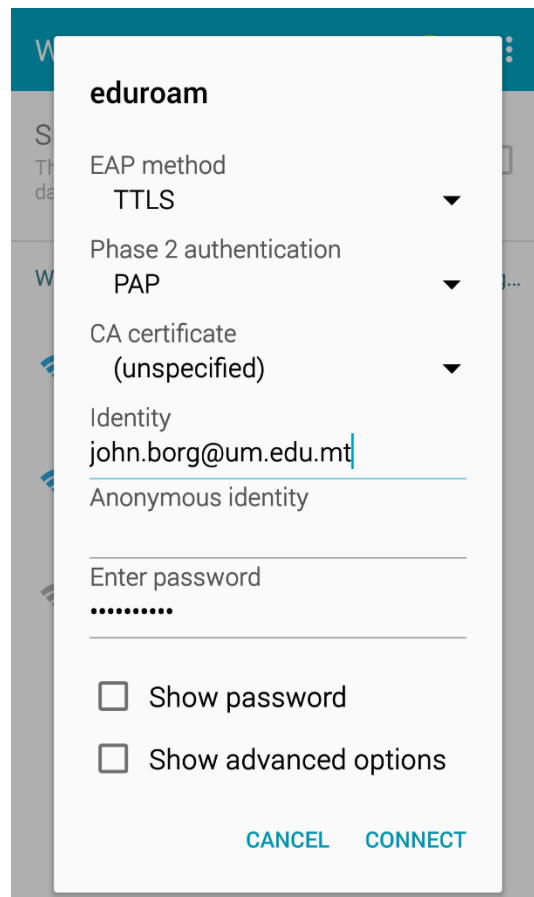
**CA Certificate:** Leave 'unspecified' or 'Please Specify'

Note: Some Android 7 mobiles may need to be set to 'Do Not Validate'

**Identity:** University/Junior College email address

**Password:** Your corresponding University or Junior College email password



- Tap **Connect**. Your android is now configured to connect to eduroam. Click on **eduroam** from the list of wireless networks if you are not connected automatically.
