

WETTINGER, GODFREY (22.12.1929), Historian.

Born at Mosta, Wettinger received his education at the Lyceum and St. Michael's College. Lived at Mellieha, 1931-64 and at St Julian's 1964- . He taught in primary schools, at the Lyceum and at the Junior College. Wettinger graduated BA in History as an external student of London University (1953), MA (1965), and Ph.D. (1971). Lectured at the UM from 1972 onwards, and later became Head of the Department of History, Chairman of the Faculty of Arts, Professor (1991), and Dean of the Faculty of Arts. For several times he was a member of Senate. He often spent long spells abroad at London, Oxford, Palermo and other places of archival research. A founding member (1951), past editor of the journal *Melita Historica*, and past president of the Malta Historical Society, Wettinger was nominated member of the National Order of Merit (MOM) in 1996.
