

This user guide assists University of Malta staff and students to set up eduroam on their laptop running Mac OS X 10.7 (Lion) to connect to the wireless network at UM and at other institutions participating in the eduroam initiative.

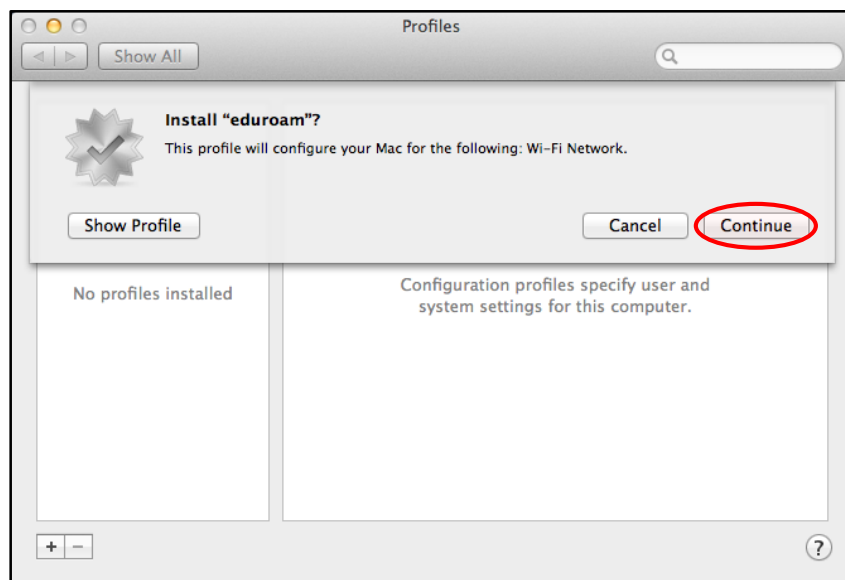

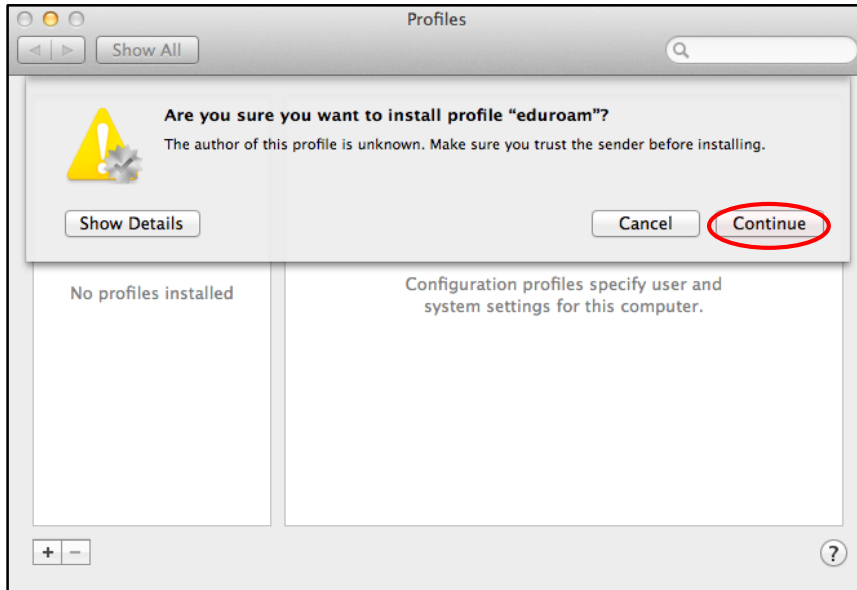
To set up eduroam on your laptop you need to download a custom configuration file (UM eduroam.mobileconfig) as indicated below.

To set up eduroam:

1. Visit any University of Malta web page.
2. Click **Quicklinks** at the top right of the webpage.
3. Choose **Manage UM IT Account**.
4. Click **Connect to eduroam**.
5. Click **Download configuration file (Mac OS X Lion)**.
6. Double-click the configuration file downloaded in step 5 to start the installation.
7. Click **Continue** button to install the eduroam configuration file.



8. Click **Continue** button to proceed with installing the profile 'eduroam'.



9. Enter/set the details:

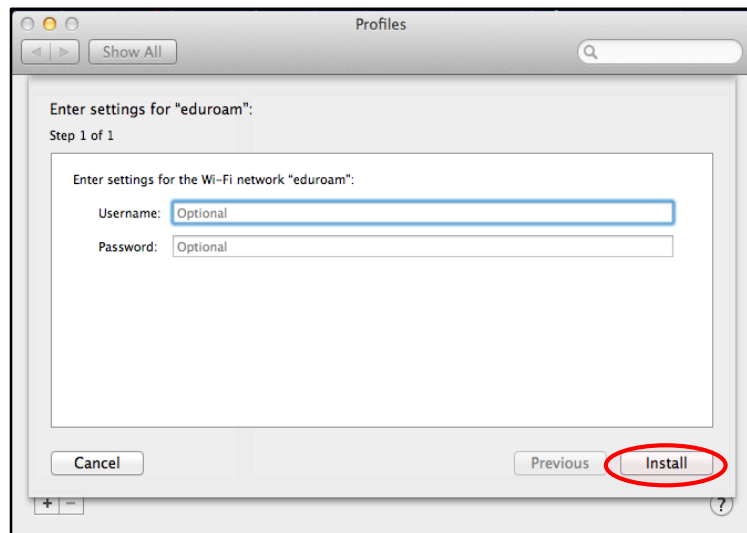

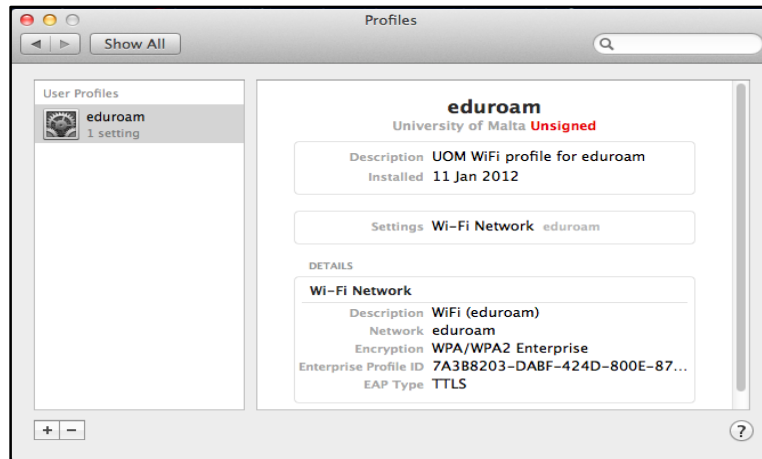
10. Click **Install** button.

11. Enter your Mac OS password to proceed with the installation.



12. Click **OK** button.

13. The window displayed below confirms that the configuration file for eduroam has been successfully installed. Restart the laptop.



14. When you are within an eduroam network range, click the **Airport** icon and select **eduroam**.
