



**ELECTION OF TWO STUDENT REPRESENTATIVES ON THE BOARD OF THE  
FACULTY OF ECONOMICS, MANAGEMENT AND ACCOUNTANCY  
(at least one vacancy is for a postgraduate student)**

In terms of Article 80(e) of the Education Act (Cap. 327) an election by and from the student body was held on Thursday, 9<sup>th</sup> November, 2017 to elect two students to sit on the Board of the Faculty of Economics, Management and Accountancy for a period of two years.
