This will not influence any other arrangements outside this requirement.</i></p>		
MNH4002	Rights and Responsibilities in Mental Health Care	6 ECTS Credits
<p>Available for: Applicants in possession of a license to practice in Health, Education, Science, Social Sciences and Theology. Police officers, army officers and other individuals in employment in areas deemed suitable by the Board can also apply. If an applicant has a license to practice, this must be provided. In the absence of a warrant, applicants are to provide a signed confirmation letter from their employer, describing the individual's work duties. 9 remaining places. Minimum number of students for course to commence: 10.</p>		
MID4012	Perineal Care and Repair for Midwives	4 ECTS Credits
<p>Available for: Registered midwives. Preference will be given to midwives working in the Labour suite. 10 remaining places.</p>		
POD5001	Vascular Assessment of the Lower Extremities	4 ECTS Credits
<p>Available for: All health care professionals holding a B.Sc. (Hons.) Degree and health care professionals with a Diploma and 5 years' clinical experience in Podiatry. Minimum number of students for course to commence: 5.</p>		
RAD5116	Radiopharmacy: Production and Clinical Applications	5 ECTS Credits
<p>Available for: Registered Radiographers in possession of a qualification in Radiography at EQF Level 6.</p>
