



**ELECTION OF TWO STUDENT REPRESENTATIVES ON
THE BOARD OF THE CENTRE FOR LABOUR STUDIES**

TO ALL STUDENTS

In terms of Article 4(vi) of the Statute of the Centre for Labour Studies, **two members are elected by and from among the students of the Centre**. In accordance with Article 83(1) the term of office is of two years.

There are **two** vacancies on the Board of the Centre for Labour Studies and the term of office shall extend from 3 March 2017 till 2 March 2019.

Nominations, on forms available from the University of Malta website (www.um.edu.mt/studentrepresentatives), are to be handed in at the **Office of the Registrar (Room 209), Administration Building** by not later than **noon of Monday, 13 February, 2017.**

Nominations are to be duly proposed and seconded by enrolled students. Nominated students are required to signify, in writing, acceptance of their nomination.

Nominations received will be published on the University of Malta website on **Tuesday, 14 February, 2017** and all students will be informed of this by email.

Eligibility to vote: All students enrolled at the Centre for Labour Studies during the current academic year.

Voting for these elections will take place on **Thursday, 2 March, 2017** between **09:00 a.m.** and **06:00 p.m.**

An **ONLINE** election system will be used. On the day of the election, you will receive an e-mail on your University e-mail account with a link to vote. You can only vote once and your voting choices will remain anonymous.
