



**ELECTION OF TWO STUDENT REPRESENTATIVES ON THE BOARD OF THE  
FACULTY OF MEDICINE AND SURGERY  
(at least one vacancy is for a postgraduate student)**

In terms of Article 80(e) of the Education Act (Cap. 327), an election by and from the student body was held on Thursday, 9<sup>th</sup> November, 2017 to elect two students to sit on the Board of the Faculty of Medicine and Surgery for a period of two years.

Three students, of which one is a postgraduate student, were nominated to contest the election:

From the 162 votes cast by secret ballot, the following result was obtained:
