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ELECTION OF ONE MEMBER OF THE ACADEMIC STAFF ON COUNCIL

TO ALL MEMBERS OF THE ACADEMIC STAFF:

According to the provisions of Article 76(d) of the Education Act (Cap.327) under Act XIII of 2012, the Council includes three members elected by the academic staff from those amongst them who are not members of the Senate. The term of office is two years (cfr. Article 83(1)).

Nominations on forms available from the Office of Human Resources Management and Development, Room 217, Administration Building or by sending an email to elections.hrmd@um.edu.mt. Nominations Forms are to be handed in at the **Rector's Office**, by **noon of Wednesday, 11th September 2019**.

Nominated candidates duly proposed and seconded, are to signify in writing, acceptance of their nomination.

Nominations will be published on Newspoint and the Faculty Notice Board on **Wednesday, 11th September 2019**.

Eligibility to vote: A list of members eligible to be nominated and vote is available for perusal in Room 215, Administration Building, University of Malta, Msida.

Election: For this purpose, and if necessary, an electronic election will be held on **Wednesday, 18th September 2019** from **9.00a.m. to 9.00p.m.**

Voting rights for Council appointed Resident Academic and Visiting Teaching Staff will be in accordance with Appendix C of the Collective Agreement for Academic Staff of the University of Malta and Academic Staff of the Junior College 2014-2018.

Eligible voters must have a UM IT Account.
