The University's academic year is divided in two semesters: the first semester runs from October to January, whilst the second semester runs from February to May. Some postgraduate courses may include a summer semester (June to October) as the final semester of the course.

\* For Master's degrees mainly by research, applications may be submitted at any time of the year (applicants in possession of local qualifications against a fee of € 23.29 and applicants in possession of international qualifications against a fee of € 93) but enrolment shall be with effect from one of the following dates: 1 October, 1 December, 1 February, 1 April and 1 June. When submitting an online application, applicants are requested to indicate the month when they intend to start their research in the free text section.
