Part 1: Statistical Information

Part 2: Comments regarding candidate's performance**2.1 PAPER I: HISTORY**

This paper is made up of two sections which together cover History of Classical Greece and History of Classical Rome. The fact that very few candidates sat the exam does not allow for a detailed report on the performance. However, the level was not high and the language used to answer the essays was poor.

2.2 PAPER II: CULTURE

This paper involves three separate sections of which the Section on Greek/Roman Literature is compulsory and in the other two sections, the candidate is free to answer questions on Daily Life in Ancient Rome and/or Greek Mythology. The marks here are higher than in Paper I.
