Essays

Category 1: Levels 7, 8, and 9 (250 to 300 words)

Category 2: Levels 10 and 11 (350 to 400 words)

Category 3: Post-Secondary (500 to 600 words)

Essays can be submitted in either Maltese or English.

Posters

Open to Levels 7, 8, 9, and Special Education Schools. Posters should be **A3** size.

Short-Form Videos

Open to Levels 10, 11, and post-secondary

Length: 60 to 90 seconds.

Aspect Ratio: Preferred 9:16 (vertical) or 1:1.

Resolution: 1080x1920 pixels.
