



ALAN AYCKBOURN is described as the Golden Boy of the seventies of British comedy. His name outside a theatre is as big an attraction as that of any star.

He gave up acting in Scarborough to be able to concentrate on writing.

For the past 15 years he has been artistic director of the town's theatre-in-the-round where all his West End successes began their life. He is currently enjoying an enormous success with both audiences and critics with his four plays running at the West End... his trilogy "THE NORMAN CONQUEST" and "ABSURD PERSON SINGULAR". An Ayckbourn comedy is a comedy with a difference. As he himself says, "I don't write jokes. People laugh because they see things they recognise as familiar". Many of Ayckbourn's plays take marriage as their theme. In all of them relationships are strained but he writes about them wittily and perceptively and with a lot of caring for his characters. "How THE OTHER HALF LOVES" is Ayckbourn's shrewd observation of the devious means employed by his characters to solve their marriage problems.

LINO FARRUGIA was introduced to the theatre audiences in Malta as an actor and director of Experimental Drama when he was still a student at the Royal University of Malta. He then concentrated on radio and television work where he distinguished himself as director of various plays notably his maltese version of Lorca's "The House of Bernarda Alba". Farrugia's contribution to the theatre ranges from Greek Tragedy to present production of "How the other Half Loves". Serracino Inglott's "Raheb", Aeschylus' "Agememnon", Ebejer's festival play "vumbarala-zungare" and Pirandello's "SIX CHARACTERS IN SEARCH OF AN AUTHOR" are among the most memorable in his stage-directing career. Lino Farrugia is a resident director with the Atturi Theatre Group.
