**WORLD TELECOMMUNICATION  
DAY COMMEMORATIVE POSTAGE  
ISSUE**

THE Postmaster General notifies for general information that the Minister of Development, Energy, Port and Telecommunications has authorised the issue on Tuesday, 17th May, 1977, of a set of four postage stamps to commemorate World Telecommunication Day. The set will remain on sale up to Saturday, 31st December, 1977, unless stocks are previously exhausted.

The two designs which will be featured in this set symbolize the progress made in telecommunication and development in the Maltese Islands. The designs have been prepared by Mr Harry Borg after consultation with the Stamp Design Advisory Board.

The values and colours of the stamps will be as follows:—

<i>Value</i>	<i>Colour</i>
1c	Green, red and black
6c	Turquoise, red and black
8c	Terracotta, red and black
17c	Violet, red and black

The size of the stamps will be 20 mm. × 38 mm. perforation to perforation; the 1c and 6c values in vertical format and the 8c and 17c values in horizontal format. The perforation gauge of the stamps will be 13.6 × 14.

The stamps, which will be available in sheets of 50 each, will be printed in lithography, on Maltese Cross watermarked paper, by Printex Limited, Malta.

Requisitions from licensed stamp vendors for the supply of these stamps will be received up to and not later than 5.00 p.m. on Friday, 13th May, 1977.
