COMMONWEALTH SCHOLARSHIPS — INDIAN AWARDS FOR 1973-74

For the session 1973-74 the Government of India offer 45 scholarships and 5 fellowships as part of the Commonwealth Education Cooperation Scheme.

These scholarships are intended for men and women of high intellectual promise from other parts of the Commonwealth who may be expected to make a significant contribution to life in their own countries on their return from studies in India. They are primarily meant for postgraduate study and research in any of the universities/institutions of higher learning in India in any specific field. Undergraduate study is also permissible in cases where adequate facilities for study are not available in a Commonwealth country.

The Plan in India is administered by the Ministry of Education and Social Welfare, Government of India, New Delhi.

Tenure

Scholarships are tenable for a programme of study or research extending over a period of two academic years and leading to a university degree or a similar qualification. Exceptionally, an award may be made for one academic year only and in appropriate circumstances, e.g. a postgraduate scholar whose work for a higher degree is found to require three years, it may be extended for the third year. Each award will be made on the understanding that it will be continued for the period of the programme of study or research for which it is granted provided that the scholar's progress and conduct are satisfactory.

Value of Awards

Each scholarship is intended to cover the expenses of travel, living and study during its tenure which will be as follows:

- (a) Transportation to India and return, normally by second class rail-cum-sea passage or tourist air passage in the case of scholars, as arranged by the Indian authorities;
 - (b) Approved tuition and other compulsory university fees (excluding board and residence);
 - (c) A personal maintenance allowance at the rate of Rs.250 per month for scholars;
 - (d) A grant for books or equipment subject to a maximum of Rs. 300 per annum;
 - (e) Approved medical expenses;
 - (f) A grant for expenses of approved study tours within India and for attending approved holiday or youth welfare camps at prescribed rates;
 - (g) An outfit allowance of Rs. 200 only on joining the Institution.
- Note: These payments are not taxable in India.

The value of scholarships is adequate for the maintenance of the scholar and there is no provision for any additional allowance if a scholar brings his family with him. In the universities/institutions and hostels in India, accommodation is provided for the scholar and not for his family. Rent for private accommodation is very high in cities like Delhi, Calcutta, Madras and Bombay and consequently it is likely to be difficult for the scholar to meet the expenditure from within the maintenance allowance provided to him under the scheme, in case he decides to make his own arrangements. It would, therefore, be in the scholar's own interest

not to bring his family to India. If, however, the scholar so desires, it will be his responsibility to make arrangements for the passages, accommodation and maintenance.

Eligibility

The candidates must be citizens of a Commonwealth country and normally resident in any part of the Commonwealth other than India. They should be graduates of universities or colleges in their own countries or holders of an equivalent qualification. An award may also be made to a graduate who wishes to study for another undergraduate degree or may be made to an under-graduate if the programme of studies he wishes to follow in India is not available in his own country.

Age-limits

The scholarships are open to both men and women who will not have reached their 35th birthday on 31st December, 1973. Preference will be given to the candidates who are between 22 and 28 years of age.

Conditions for Awards

(a) Scholars are expected to return to their own countries at the end of their postgraduate or research work in India.

(b) Scholars must abide by the rules of the universities in India or other institutions in which they are placed.

(c) Scholars cannot without receiving special permission take paid employment during the tenure of their awards.

(d) Scholarship under this Plan cannot normally be held in conjunction with any other scholarship award.

(e) During the tenure of the award, the scholar will be expected to reside in India.

Language Qualifications

The medium of instruction in most of the universities/institutions in India is English, in some it is Hindi or the regional language. Candidates whose mother tongue is not English will be required to produce satisfactory evidence that they have sufficient knowledge in English.

Placement

Every effort will be made to place selected candidates in the university/institution of their choice. However, it must be emphasised that it may not always be possible for a scholar to be placed at the university/institution of his first choice.

General Information

Information concerning Indian Universities and courses available may be obtained from the Commonwealth Universities Year Book which is available for perusal at the Education Department, Valletta.

Nominations

Nominations will not normally be made in respect of candidates who have been on scholarship at any time during the three years previous to the commencement of the scholarship.

Method of Application

Application forms obtainable from the Education Department on request, accompanied by certificates relating to qualifications and experience should reach the Director of Education, 90 West Street, Valletta by not later than noon of Saturday, 13th January, 1973.

Short List

A short list of applications will be prepared by the Local Commonwealth Scholarship Committee and only candidates appearing on the short list will be requested to attend for interview.

Other Information

Incomplete application forms and application forms not accompanied by the required certificates and application forms received after the closing date will not be considered.


