AND WHEREAS I have been advised by the Prime Minister to dissolve Parliament from the 9th day of November, 1981;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the power vested in me as aforesaid, I, ANTON BUTTIGIEG, President of Malta, do hereby notify and proclaim that the Parliament of Malta be and is hereby dissolved from the 9th day of November, 1981.
