MANOEL THEATRE ON TOUR

Is an out of season activity organised for the first time last Summer on the initiative of ambassador John Lowell, Chairman of the Manoel theatre Management Committee, whereby a number of promising young musicians are invited to perform abroad as a bond of friendship with a host country and Malta.

Last year the host country was Italy where the Manoel Theatre on Tour Ensembles gave three successful concerts at Grosseto, Cecina and Terme Di Chianciano and have visited important towns as Pisa and Firenze. A visit to one of the Baltic states is on the agenda of the Manoel Theatre Management Committee for the Summer Season.

CANTORES SANCTI JULIANI

The choir was founded in 1982 by Miss Elvia Agius for children - boys and girls from the age of 6 upwards. It has established itself as a unique cathedral choir in Malta and boasts of a wide repertoire consisting mainly of Sacred Works.

In March 1998, the choir participated successfully in the V^o International Choir Festival "Orlando di Lasso" held in Rome and the Vatican City where it placed second in the *voci bianche* category and was awarded a special medal *for the best youngest participation*.

During the same year it participated in the non-competitive International Children's Choir Festival at the Mdina Cathedral and in Environment Day Concert organised by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs at the Manoel Theatre.

The Choir's busy schedule last year culminated in the Millennium Celebrations. Later on the choir will be participating in the XLVIII International Choral Festival at Arezzo, Italy.
