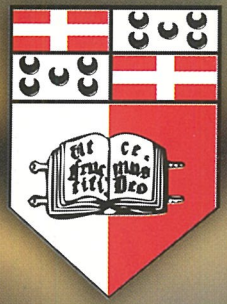

CALENDAR

Dates for the Academic Year 2006 – 2007 are as follows:

1st Term: Monday, 2nd October, 2006 – Friday, 22nd December, 2006.

Christmas Recess: Monday, 25th December, 2006 – Sunday 7th January, 2007.

2nd Term: Monday, 8th January, 2007 – Friday, 30th March, 2007.

Easter Recess: Monday, 2nd April, 2007 – Sunday, 15th April, 2007. (Easter Sunday on 8th April, 2007)

SUMMER RECESS
