Julius, Charles, industrialist and mineral-water manufacturer, established in Malta; died in Sliema on Thursday, 4th August 1892.

Jaccarini, Dr Francis, B.Sc., M.D. - (1884-1935) - Medical practitioner.

Born in 1884, he graduated in Medicine at the Malta University in 1903; entered the government service and was district medical officer at Cospicua and later, at Floriana. He was an Officer of the Crown of Italy. Died at his country residence at Sta. Paola, Rabat, on Thursday, 15th August 1935, aged 51 years, and was buried at the Addolorata Cemetery at 6 pm on August 16. Survived by his widow, nee Ghisla, his five children; a brother, the Rev. S. Jaccarini O.M.C., and a sister, Sister Pia Jaccarini, of the Sisters of Charity.

Jatroudakis, Paul - (1854-1935) - Merchant, one of the oldest and most respected members of the Greek commercial community, established in Malta, died on the morning of Friday, the 16th August 1935, aged 81 years, and was buried in La Braxia Cemetery, Peki at 9 a.m. on August 17.

Survived by his widow and two sons, the Emmanuel Jatroudakis, Greek Consul in Malta, and George Jatroudakis, resident in Athens, Greece.

Jenkin John, L.D.S. - (1842-1917) - Surgeon Dentist, established for 56 years in Malta, where he enjoyed an extensive practice in his profession, with a clinic in Sta. Reale, Valletta. Died at his residence, No. 46 Sta. Birkicara, St. Julian's, at 5.30 a.m. on Tuesday, 20th November 1917, following a brief illness from pneumonia, aged 75 years.

Survived by his wife, two sons, one of whom Thomas G. Jenkin L.D.S. and two daughters; buried at La Braxia Cemetery on Nov 21.
