

A LIST OF RECORDS OF SOME RARE VASCULAR PLANT SPECIES OCCURRING IN THE MALTESE ISLANDS (CENTRAL MEDITERRANEAN)

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ABSTRACT

A check-list of one hundred and twenty-three (123) rare or infrequent vascular plant species occurring in the Maltese Islands is hereby given, along with brief notes concerning the record date and location, population size and distribution on the islands.

Keywords: rare, infrequent, vascular plant species, Maltese Islands

KEY

In compiling the following species list, the author has followed the family sequence adopted by Lanfranco 2001.

For each species, the localities where populations of the species were discovered by the author are given. The wider district where a specific locality is situated is given when:

a) the locality name is a micronym known only by a handful of farmers who happen to live or own land in the same locality, eg. Dingli cliffs area (district): Rdum ta' Flurrieqa (micronym);

b) when a single toponym serves different specific localities that are well separated geographically, eg. Il-Mosta area: (district) Wied Hanžir (a toponym for at least 3 different valleys in Malta and Gozo).

(P.1) = Other records for this species are listed in **Part 1** published in The Central Mediterranean Naturalist Volume 4 Part 3, 2007.

(P?) = Specimens found are doubtfully autochthonous and may have been planted.

* = Species no longer found in specific locality.

(Number) = Number of individuals found in a locality on date of discovery.

The list covers a period of research from Spring 1991 to Summer 2008. The date on which each species was first discovered is given in brackets. In cases where the exact date of discovery was not recorded, an approximate date is given:

(early 1990's) = found between 1991 and 1995;
(late 1990's) = found between 1996 and 1999;

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(c. xxxx)= found in the year xxxx or up to 2 years before or after that year.

In some cases (eg. *Medicago monspeliaca*), identification was made from dead dessicated specimens found during the summer drought, not during the active growth season. Identification was made possible by the presence of the distinctive fruits that were well preserved.

GOZO - Mgarr ix-Xini (12-1992) - il-Munxar area: Wied tal-Ġħawdxija (14-11-2007) - Ta' Ċenċ area: Fuq tal-Gruwa (18-10-2005) - ix-Xagħra area: abundant among boulder scree and rubble walls at il-Pergla, Ghajnejha Barrani, Rdum tas-Surġu, Rdum ta' Kilulu (21-3-2004) (possibly the most extensive population in the country, at places dominating continuous stretches of 20m square or more) - Wied Ilma (below Ghajnejha hill) (21-10-2006) - Wied is-Sabbar (26-1-2008) - iż-Żewwieqa (9-12-2007).

C.cirrhosa was recorded in the past as: " *Malta, qua e la ...Gozo, piuttosto rara* " (Sommier & Caruana Gatto 1915). Seems to have increased and become frequent, abundant in some areas, probably due to the elimination of grazing herds.

7. *Ranunculus arvensis* L.

Partial to cultivated fields with clay soils.

8. *Ranunculus bulbosus* subsp.*aleae* (Willkomm) Rouy & Foucault

MALTA - il-Baħrija area: valleybed between il-Qlejha and it-Tulliera (1992) - il-Bidnija area (21-12-2002) - il-Fiddien (1992), Wied il-Qlejha (c. 2001) valley system - Wied il-Fulija (vicinity of is-Salib tal-Ġħolja) (12-2005) - Wied Gerzuma (1992) - Wied l-Isperanza, Wied il-Ġħasel valley system (1993) - Wied il-Heġri (1992) - Wied il-Ħamar (vicinity of tas-Santi) (7-3-2008) - Wied il-Luq, Wied tal-Ġirgenti valley system (1992) - Wied ta' Seqla (vicinity of l-Imselliet) (13-4-2002) - Wied Xkora (3-2000), Wied Hanżir, Wied Qirda, Wied il-Kbir, il-Marsa (1992) valley system.

9. *Ranunculus ficaria* L.

10. *Ranunculus trichophyllum* Chaix

MALTA - il-Fiddien, Wied il-Qliegħa valley system (late 1990's) - Wied tal-Girgenti (1992)* - Wied tal-Hżejjen (13-4-2002).

11. *Hypecoum imberbe* Smith

MALTA - Ghajnej Tuffieħha area: il-Wita tat-Torri (2008); it-Tafal (21-5-2008) - Marfa peninsula: Wied ta' Msid / tal-Merħla (2002); Wied ta' l-Armier (12-3-2008) (possibly the largest population in the country).

GOZO - tal-Bardan (5-3-2008) - il-Qala area: il-Gwiedi (19-4-2005) - San Lawrenz area: tal-Foqra (along road down to id-Dwejra) (1995); l-Almagħaq (20-2-2008) - Santa Lucija area: ta' Klula (5-4-2004).

A rare agrospecies found in fields with shallow soil, among grain and animal fodder crops, often near the coast.

Family: *Urticaceae*

12. *Parietaria lusitanica* L. (P.1)

MALTA - H'Attard area: Trejjet ir-Regin (17-3-2008) - Marfa peninsula: Rdum il-Qawwi, rocks below il-Minjel ta' Piswella (25-5-2008) - Ras il-Pellegrin (7-4-2008).

GOZO - il-Munxar area: Wied tal-Għawdxija (30-11-2007) - ix-Xaghra area: ta' Foghtier / taħt in-niċċa (24-11-2007) - very abundant in boulder screes and old rubble walls at iż-Żewwieqa, il-Hawlija, iż-Żebbuġ, tal-Bombli (7-12-2007), up to below il-Wied ta' Rdum (opposite il-GeVbla tal-Halfa) (27-1-2008) (possibly the largest and most extensive population in the country).

13. *Urtica pilulifera* L.

MALTA - frequent along roads and country-lanes at Bubaqra, in-Nigret area (2002) - Hal Far area: ta' Rikka (15-3-2005), Triq Hal Far (between iż-Żurrieq and tal-Baqqari) (20-12-2002), Wied Moqbol / Wied Brandina (20-3-2004) - Hal Ghargħur: Triq iż-Żellieqa (5-4-2000)* - Wied Qirda, Wied il-Kbir valley system (1992) - Xrobb l-Għażiex (1) (12-3-2003).

Family: *Juglandaceae*

14. *Juglans regia* L.

MALTA - il-Kunċizzjoni (overlooking Wied il-Hmar and tas-Santi) (27-8-1996) (These trees have trunks as massive as those of the oaks at Ballut tal-Wardija and could be of great antiquity) - Ġnien Fieres (late 1990's).

Family: *Aizoaceae*

15. *Mesembryanthemum crystallinum* L.

MALTA - Marsascala: on coast alongside Triq is-Salini (2003) - Pembroke coast (late 1990's) - Tigne (early 1990's).

GOZO - ir-Ramla l-Hamra sand dunes (2) (1995)*; under *Tamarix* trees adjacent to ir-Ramla l-Hamra sandy beach (9-4-2008) - Santa Luċija / il-Kerċem area: along road between ta' Klula up to Wied Sansun (5-4-2004).

16. *Silene fruticosa* L.

GOZO - Mgarr ix-Xini (12-1992).

Family : *Polygonaceae*

17. *Fallopia convolvulus* (L.) L.A.Love

MALTA - il-Baħrija area: ta' Namura (30-5-2008) - fields around il-Ballut tal-Wardija (22-5-2008) - ħad-Dingli: is-Sienja (17-6-2008) - Ģnien il-Kbir (28-5-2008) - il-Girgenti area: l-Ğajnej il-Kbira (11-2003) - il-Mosta: Triq Wied is-Sijr (15-6-2008) - ir-Rabat area: Ģnien Fieres (31-5-2008); ta' Koronja (2003) - San Martin (22-5-2008) - Wied Gerżuma (30-5-2008) - Wied il-Luq (28-5-2008).

Grows in cultivated fields with deep soil.

18. *Persicaria glabra* (Willdenow) M.Gomez

MALTA - Wied il-Ħżejjen (2002).

GOZO - Wied Sara (10-6-2008).

19. *Persicaria lanigera* (R.Brown) Sojak

GOZO - Wied il-Ġhasri (30-9-2000) - Wied Sara, Wied tal-Grazzja valley system (10-1992).

20. *Persicaria senegalensis*

MALTA - l-Ğajnej il-Kbira, il-Girgenti valley system (1992) - il-Mosta area: Wied ta' San Pawl tal-Qliegħi, Wied Hanżira valley system (1999).

Family: *Plumbaginaceae*

21. *Plumbago europaea* L. (P.1)

MALTA - is-Siġġiewi area: Triq l-Imwieġel (11-10-2007); Blat il-Qamar (8-11-2007) - Wied Qannotta (1998) - plane between Wied Qirda and Wied Hanżir (23-5-2008).

Family: *Brassicaceae*

22. *Cardamine hirsuta* L.

MALTA - il-Buskett: Verdala (late 1990's) - l-Għar ta' San Brinkat (vicinity of Wied Ānglu) (late 1990's) - Wied il-Għasel area: Wied is-Sijr, l-Għadira (2001).
GOZO - il-Munxar area: Wied tal-Ġħawdxija (30-11-2007).

A frequent weed of potted plant nurseries; very rare in non-anthropogenic habitats, where it grows on well shaded damp rocks.

23. *Lepidium graminifolium* L.

MALTA - ir-Rabat area: il-Fiddien, Wied il-Qlejha valley system (3-2001); l-Għerriexem, near ic-Čimiteju ta' Santa Margerita and Roman Villa, is-Saqqajja, Triq it-Tigrijiet (late 1990's); along uphill road between ir-Rabat and il-Baħrija (late 1990's); Wied ta' Ģnien Hira (late 1990's).

Common in Gozo; hence no records are given.

Grows manily along roadsides in urban areas and country lanes, rarely in wet valleybeds.

24. *Nasturtium officinale* R.Brown

MALTA - il-Baħrija area: several places including ta' Namura, tas-Sarena, valleybed between il-Qlejħi and tat-Tulliera, Wied il-Mielah (8-1992) - il-Fiddien, Wied il-Qlejħa valley system (1992) - Ĝebel id-Dwejra, Ģnien Hira, il-Qattara, start of Wied il-Hemsija valley system (late 1990's) - l-Imtaħleb area: Wied ta' Markozz (1992) - il-Mellieħha area: Ghajnej Hadid (14-3-2000) - San Martin (7-1992) - Wied tal-Ġnejna / Wied taċ-Ċercura (1992) - Wied Ghajnej Mula (13-4-2002) - Wied tal-Hmar (vicinity of tas-Santi) (27-8-1996) - Wied il-Luq (1992); at meeting point between Wied il-Luq and Wied tal-Girgenti (1995).

GOZO - id-Dwejra area: il-Qattara (7-1993) - l-Imgarr area: il-Ġnien (early 1990's) - Wied tal-Lunżjata, Fontana valley system (29-7-1994) - Wied tas-Sasis / Wied tal-Petroċilju, Wied il-Għasri valley system (30-9-2000).

25. *Neslia apiculata* Fischer, Mayer & Ave-Lallemont (P.1)

GOZO - il-Qala area: ta' Cassar, ta' Simar (plateau overlooking Wied is-Simar) (19-2-2008).

26. *Sinapis arvensis* L.

MALTA - l-Aħrax tal-Mellieħha area: il-Qatgħa ta' Pleġġ (12-3-2008) - il-Baħrija area: ta' Xafura (overlooking Fomm ir-riħ bay) (c.2001) - Fort Bengħisa area: tal-Harrub (2002) - Ghajnej Tuffieħha area: it-Tafal (21-5-2008) - il-Mellieħha area: il-Qortin (facing il-Manikata) (31-1-2007); between it-Torri l-Aħmar and *acacia* wood below (13-6-2003); between it-Torri l-Aħmar and Triq Ghajnej Tuta (2-9-2004) - on il-Magħtab refuse dump debris (9-11-2003) - Wied ta' Kandja (2000) - Wied is-Sewda (13-8-2007) - Wied Żnuber (13-3-2004).

Common in Gozo; hence no records are given. Infrequent in Malta.

27. *Rapistrum rugosum* (L.) Allioni (P.1)

MALTA - Dingli cliffs area: il-Faqqanija quarries (2-6-2008) - il-Girgenti area: Ċens Mota (2-6-2008).

Family: *Malvaceae*

28. *Lavatera trimestris* L.

MALTA - fields between il-Ballut tal-Wardija and Għajnej Istan, Wied tal-Pwales (22-5-2008) - il-Buskett (30-3-2004) - Ģnien il-Kbir (28-5-2008) - Ģnien is-Sultan (31-5-2008) - l-Imtarfa area: Ĝebel id-Dwejra (late 1990's) - ir-Ronzija (?) (between tal-Virtu and Wied l-Isqof) (28-5-2008) - Wied il-Hamar (vicinity of Tas-Santi) (c. 2000) - Wied ir-Rum (1994).

Family: *Euphorbiaceae*

29. *Andrachne telephiooides* L.

MALTA - l-Aħrax tal-Mellieħha area: fields near it-Telgħa tal-Aħrax (12-3-2008) - h'Attard (17-3-2008) - Bubaqra area: il-Bur ta' l-Imtoli (24-6-2003) - around Ĝebel Ciantar quarries (2-6-2008) - Ģnien il-Far hamlet (overlooking il-Buskett) (18-2-2008) - Ģnien Ingraw (early 1990's) - ta' Glidi (between l-Imnajdra Temple and it-Torri tal-Hamrija) (14-2-2008) - l-Imdawwra (overlooking Wied il-Bassasa) (18-10-2007) - l-Imgarr area: il-Ħawlija (7-3-2008) - frequent at il-Kappara, San Ĝwann tal-Ğargħar area (1991), including Wied Ghollieqa (1991)* - il-Mosta area: Triq il-Bežbiżja (2008) - ir-Rabat area: Triq il-Buskett (early 1990's) - San Martin (7-1992).

Usually found between street pavement cobblestones in urban areas and country lanes, occasionally in cultivated fields, rarely on rocks.

30. *Euphorbia aleppica* L. (P.1)

MALTA - Dingli cliffs area: in fields between Bejt il-Fenek and ta' Sabbgħat (9-6-2008).

Family: *Crassulaceae*

31. *Sedum caespitosum* (Cavanilles) DC. (P.1)

MALTA - il-Baħrija area: Wied il-Mielah, Ras ir-Raħeb clifftops (overlooking Fomm ir-Riħ) (30-5-2008) - l-Aħrax tal-Mellieħha area: il-Madonna ta' l-Aħrax (19-4-2008) - ix-Xaghra ta' Lawrenti (overlooking Buskett) (18-2-2008).

GOZO - taċ-Ċaww coastal rocks (17-4-2008) - il-Munxar area: Ras il-Fekru (10-4-2008); karstland between il-Munxar and Wied tal-Ğawdexija (10-4-2008) - ta' Sannat area: il-Qortin / Saguna cliffs (11-1-2008) - tal-Bardan (5-3-2008).

32. *Sedum litoreum* Gussone

MALTA - l-Ğallip coastline (early 1990's) - Wied id-Dis (5-4-2000).

GOZO - taċ-Ċaww coastal rocks (17-4-2008).

33. *Sedum stellatum* L. (P.1)

MALTA - Wied il-Ğħasel area: rocks close to the meeting point of Wied is-Sijr and Wied il-Ğħasel (11-3-2008).

Family: *Rosaceae*

34. *Potentilla reptans* L.

MALTA - il-Baħrija area: valleybed between tat-Tulliera and il-Qliegħi (1992) - il-Fiddien (c.2001) - Ģnien il-Kbir (1992) - l-Imtaħleb area: il-Bruka (1992) - ir-Rabat area: l-Għeriexem (late 1990's) - San Martin (7-1992) - Wied tal-Ġnejna / Wied taċ-Ċercura (2-1992) - Wied Gerżuma (1992) - Wied Hażrun (1992) - Wied l-Isperanza, Wied il-Għasel valley system (1993) - Wied il-Hesri (1992) - Wied il-Luq, Wied tal-Għirgenti, Triq tal-Għirgenti valley system (possibly the largest population in the country) (1992) - Wied Qirda, Wied il-Kbir, il-Marsa valley system (1992).

GOZO - Dahlet Qorrot (2-1993) - in a semi-permanent waterhole in the interior of Mgarr ix-Xini (12-2005) - Wied ir-Riħan (24-4-2003).

35. *Rosa sempervirens* L.

36. *Anagyris foetida* L. (P.1)

MALTA - Ģnien il-Far (overlooking Buskett) (25-3-2008).

37. *Astragalus sesameus* L.

MALTA - Laroka plateau (overlooking Buskett) (12-2-2008) - next to l-Imtaħleb church (1) (5-4-2003) - in-Nigret area (South Malta): ix-Xagħra ta' Sur Āngla karstland, then occurring intermittently downhill to il-Munqar (8-4-2003) - Ras il-Pellegrin (7-4-2008).

GOZO - iċ-Ċittadella: St. John's Demibastion (17-2-2004) - ta' ġordan hilltop (20-3-2008) - in-Nadur area: ix-Xagħra tat-Torri ta' Sopu (overlooking Rdum il-Kbir) (23-4-2003) - ta' Sannat area: il-Qortin / Saguna cliffs (5-3-2008).

Past literature records this species as "abbastanza frequente ... Gozo, in molti luoghi" (Sommier & Caruana Gatto 1915) "frequent" (Haslam et. al. 1977). For this reason, records for this species were not kept by the author prior to the year 2003. It was then noticed by Mr. E. Lanfranco to have declined dramatically and to have become infrequent. It thus became advisable to record localities where it occurs.

38. *Coronilla valentina* L.

40. *Lathyrus cicera* L. (P.1)

MALTA - l-Aħrax tal-Mellieħha area: ix-Xewkija (6) (12-3-2008) - rocky terraces overlooking Wied Babu (below il-Hotba) (16-1-2008) - Wied il-Bassasa (3-2000) - Wied Mejxu (1995) - karstland between ix-Xemxija heights and il-Mižieb woodland (5) (28-1-2007).

41. *Medicago lupulina* L.

MALTA - Laroka plateau (overlooking il-Buskett) (4-2008) - Mgarr area: ix-Xagħra taż-Żingier (3-2007) - il-Wardija area: behind Palazzo Gauci (25-4-2007) - Wied il-Għasel area: between il-Knisja tal-Ġhar and turning point to Misrah Ghonoq (4-2002) - ix-Xagħra tat-Tombu (near l-Imsekkiet school) (13-4-2002).

M.lupulina was recorded in the past as: " *Malta e Gozo, commune !* " (Sommier & Caruana Gatto 1915); " common " (Haslam et al. 1977). Seems to have declined dramatically.

42. *Medicago marina* L.

MALTA - ir-Ramla tal-Mellieħha (3) (early 1990's)* - ir-Ramla tal-Mixquqa / ir-Ramla ta' Snien / Golden Bay (1991).

GOZO - ir-Ramla l-Hamra (1992) (the largest surviving population).

43. *Medicago monspeliaca* (L.) Trautvetter (P.1)

46. *Trifolium tomentosum* L.

GOZO - ix-Xlendi valley (c.2004).

T. tomentosum was recorded in the past as: “*Malta, Gozo e Comino, comune !*” (Sommier & Caruana Gatto 1915); “frequent” (Haslam et al. 1977) and was as common as *Trifolium resupinatum* L. until the 1960's (E. Lanfranco, pers.com.). Hence no records were kept during the 1990's, until the author realised that it was no longer as common as past records indicate. Seems to have declined dramatically and is now infrequent.

47. *Vicia tenuissima* (Bieberstein) Schinz et Thellung (P.1)

51. *Tribulus terrestris* L.

GOZO - fields behind ir-Ramla l-Hamra sand dunes (8-1992).

Seems to be increasing as its preferred habitat, polluted dusty places, increases.

53. *Apium nodiflorum* (L.) Lagasca

Increasing and now the dominant species in most permanent watercourses due to soaring levels of nitrogenous pollution and anthropogenic disturbance. Often takes over completely after valleybeds are bulldozed.

54. *Bupleurum lancifolium* Hornemann

GOZO - il-Qala area: il-Gwiedi (19-2-2008) - Ix-Xagħra area: fields around il-Qortin refuse dump (19-9-2007).

B. lancifolium was recorded in the past as: " *Malta, non raro, ed in alcuni luoghi abbondante!* " (Sommier & Caruana Gatto 1915); " *locally frequent* " (Haslam et al. 1977). For this reason, records were not usually kept prior to the year 2000. It was then noted by Mr. E. Lanfranco to have declined and was now infrequent. It thus became advisable to record localities where it occurs.

55. *Eryngium maritimum* L.

56. *Oenanthe globulosa* L.

O.globulosa was recorded in the past as: " *frequente* " (Sommier & Caruana Gatto 1915); " *frequent* " (Haslam et al. 1977); and was found in all permanent watercourses until the 1960's (E. Lanfranco pers.com). Seems to have declined dramatically.

57. *Pseudorlaya pumila* (L.) Grande

GOZO - ir-Ramla l-Hamra (6) (1995)*.

Not seen again after the above mentioned date; may be extinct.

Family: *Rhamnaceae*

58. *Zizyphus zizyphus* (L.) Meikle

MALTA - l-Imtaħleb area: Wied ta' Ĝhar Ilma (early 1990's) - Wied ta' Bingemma / il-Ġnien ta' Bingemma (3-11-2007).

GOZO - Daħlet Qorrot (2-1993) - ta' Ĝhammar hill flanks (9-11-2006).

Family: *Sambucaceae*

59. *Sambucus ebulus* L.

MALTA - Ģnien il-Kbir, Ģnien iż-Żgħir (vicinity of Wied ta' l-Isqof) (1992) - ir-Rabat area: Ģnien Fieres (2001).

GOZO - Fontana area: Wara l-Biċċerija, ir-razzett tal-Ġajnejn il-Kbira (29-7-1994).

60. *Sambucus nigra* L.

Unlikely to be indigenous. Formerly much cultivated for its medicinal properties. Always found near old farmsteads.

Family: *Valerianaceae*

61. *Centranthus calcitrapae* (L.) Dufresne

GOZO - Mgarr ix-Xini (12-2005) - ix-Xagħra area: Ghajnejn Barrani, Rdum tas-Surgu, Rdum ta' Kilulu (21-3-2004) - Rdum il-Kbir (vicinity of San Blas) (2003) - iż-Żewwieqa (23-2-2008).

62. *Centranthus ruber* (L.) DC.

MALTA - ħ'Attard: on old walls near Triq Sant Antnin (17-3-2008).

GOZO - on an escarpment at Wied tal-Ġħattuq (22-11-2007).

Frequently cultivated as a pot plant in the past. It is thus difficult to ascertain whether the wild plants found are truly indigenous or long naturalized. However the Gozo population may be autochthonous since it is growing in its typical phytocoenosis: a limestone escarpment, among native garrigue vegetation.

Family: *Convolvulaceae*

63. *Calystegia sepium* (L.) R.Brown

MALTA - in fruit orchards and among thickets at San Martin (3-2000).

GOZO - among a stand of *Arundo donax* behind ir-Ramla l-Hamra sand dunes (19-7-2006).

64. *Calystegia silvatica* (Kitaibel) Grisebach

MALTA - h'Attard area: in a *Bougainvillea* hedge at San Anton gardens (17-3-2008); Wied ta' l-Irmiedi (17-5-2008); Wied il-Hemsija, Wied ta' Ċampra valley system (17-3-2008) - in fruit orchards and among reeds at Ģnien il-Kbir (1992) - Wied il-Luq (*Confined to il-Buskett area in 1992; spread to Għirgenti borehole by 28-5-2008*) - Wied ta' l-Imsida (1992).

GOZO - 1-Għasri area: Wied tas-Sasis / Wied tal-Petroċilju (10-6-2008).

65. *Calystegia x lucana* (Tenore) G.Don

MALTA - in orchards and among reeds at Ģnien il-Kbir (1992) - in orchards and among thickets at San Martin (3-2000) - Wied l-Isperanza, Wied il-Għasel valley system (2001) (*Only 2 specimens were seen in 2001. But by 12-11-2006, much of the valleybed was colonized, climbing shrubs like Rubus ulmifolius and Ricinis communis*) - Wied il-Luq (1992) (*Confined to il-Buskett area in 1992; spread as far as Għirgenti borehole by 28-5-2008*).

Calystegia sp. pl. were recorded in the past as: "Malta, raro, trovato soltanto a ġnien il Għbir! e al Boschetto (Borg)" (Sommier & Caruana Gatto 1915); "endangered" (Lanfranco 1989). They seem to be currently increasing and spreading rapidly. This may be due to an increase in suitable habitat: well shaded places with hedges and reeds for twining climbing stems. Most valleybeds are now dominated by extensive dense stands of *Arundo donax*, since such reeds are rarely harvested nowadays. Dense thickets of *Rubus ulmifolius* are also common since firewood is no longer collected and grazing has greatly diminished. *Ricinus communis*, an alien shrub with tall stems, has now infested most valleybeds too. Also, today farmers have much less time for weeding orchards.

Family: *Boraginaceae*

66. *Echium sabulicola* Pомel

GOZO - abundant on cliff-tops between tal-Bardan, il-Qortin / Saguna cliffs (ta' Sannat area), Ta' Ċenċ area to Wied is-Sabbara (1993), sometimes forming extensive meadows.

Family: *Lamiaceae*

67. *Ballota nigra* L.

MALTA - il-Baħrija area (1992) - Birkirkara area: alongside Triq Mannerino (1992)*; an unbuilt plot alongside Triq il-Kan.Indri Galea (2006) - Blata l-Bajda: an unbuilt plot alongside Triq l-Ispartani (1991)* - Ģnien Ghajnej Tuffieha (14-5-1996) - Gwardamangia: near St. Luke's hospital entrance (1992)*; behind Junior College Upper Lyceum (1992)* - Ghajnej Hamiem watercourse (vicinity of l-Imtarfa station) (late 1990's) - l-Imtaħleb area: il-Frajna (1992) - il-Pieta: outside Ta' Braxia Cemetery back gate (late 1990's) - San Ĝwann area: alongside Vjal ir-Riħan (15-6-2008) - Wied Balluta (1991) - Wied tal-Buskett, Wied il-Luq, Wied tal-Ġirgenti, Ghajnej il-Kbira valley system, also near Għirgenti borehole (1992) - Wied Qirda, Wied il-Kbir valley system (1992) - University of Malta campus (1991).

GOZO - Dahlet Qorrot (2-1993) - Fontana area: Wara l-Biċċerija (29-7-1994) - l-Għasri: a lane branching from Triq il-Fanal (2-2002)* - Hondoq ir-Rummien area: ta' Għaroba (1997) - l-Imġarr (early 1990's) - along uphill road from l-Imġarr to in-Nadur (19-7-2006) - il-Pergla (5-1994) - under olive trees along road between ta' Sannat and taċ-Ċawla (ir-Rabat area) (11-1-2008) - Wied tal-Ġattuq (22-11-2007) - Wied ta' Marsalforn (1) (16-10-2002) - along Wied ir-Riħan road (20-6-2005) - Wied tax-Xlendi (1994) - ix-Xaghra area: Ghajnej Xejba (late 1990's) - ix-Xewkija area: Wied Hanżira (1993).

68. *Melissa officinalis* L.

GOZO - abundant along the watercourse at Wied tal-Ġhattuq, Wied tal-Ġhažien (22-11-2007).

Unlikely to be indigenous; probably an archeophyte. Formerly much cultivated by apiarists as crushed leaves were used to attract honeybee swarms into pottery jars.

69. *Phlomis fruticosa* L.

70. *Rosmarinus officinalis* L.

71. *Stachys ocymastrum* (L.) Briquet (P.1)

GOZO - ta' ġħammar hill clay flanks (20-3-2008).

72. *Teucrium scordium* L.

MALTA - il-Baħrija area: valleybed between il-Qliegħi and tat-Tulliera (1992)*.

Population suddenly reduced to 1 clump in 1996, then completely wiped out in the late 1990's when a mass of dead Arundo donax reeds heaped up in the valleybed, smothering watercourse vegetation. Now extinct in the

wild. The author has conserved the species by cultivating it in his own private garden from seeds and rhizome cuttings collected at il-Baħrija.

73. *Vitex agnus-castus* L.

COMINO - Santa Marija bay (9-1992).

Family: *Solanaceae*

74. *Lycium intricatum* Boissier

MALTA - l-Aħrax tal-Mellieħha area: Rdum il-Ħmar, l-Aħrax ta' Ĝewwa, il-Qatgħa ta' Plegg, tax-Xilep (12-3-2008) - Had-Dingli area: Hal Tartarni (late 1990's) - il-Magħtab (late 1990's) - il-Mellieħha area: Ģnien Ingraw (7) (2000) - il-Wardija area: alongside Triq il-Wardija (25-4-2007).

GOZO - ta' Cassia (between id-Dabrani and is-Salvatur hills) (13-3-2003) - flanks of il-Qolla s-Safra (11-3-2003).

Family: *Scrophulariaceae*

75. *Kickxia elatine* (L.) Dumortier (P.1)

GOZO - id-Dwejra area: Wied ta' Kerrex, Wied ta' l-Abatija (12-6-2008) - abundant at l-Ehbiel (fields along highway between Tal-Ħniena, ix-Xewkija, and it-Torri, Ghajnsielem) (10-6-2008) - Ghajnsielem area: fields along Triq il-Qieghan (27-6-2008) - il-Kerċem area: ix-Xejriet (hill opposite facing Ghajnejja Għabdun) (12-6-2008) - fields alongside Triq l-Għarb (12-6-2008) - Wied Marsalforn (4-6-2008).

Frequent in Gozo; rare in Malta. Usually grows in wheat fields, flourishing after the harvest, during early Summer.

76. *Kickxia commutata* (Bernhardi) Fritsch

MALTA - Wied Babu (1992) - Wied Qirda (1992).

Unlike other *Kickxia* present in the Maltese islands, *K. commutata* does not grow in cultivated fields but in dry valleybeds.

Recorded in the past as: " abbastanza frequente "(Sommier & Caruana Gatto 1915); " locally frequent " (Haslam et al. 1977). In the author's experience, it is now much rarer than these literature references indicate.

77. *Linaria pseudolaxiflora* Lojacono (P.1)

GOZO - abundant on clifftops along il-Qortin / Saguna cliffs (ta' Sannat area), tal-Bardan, Sanap cliffs (il-Munxar area) (5-3-2008) (possibly the largest population in the country) - ta' Għammar hilltop (20-3-2008) - ta' ġordan hilltop (20-3-2008).

Frequent in Gozo; very rare in Malta.

78. *Veronica anagallis-aquatica* L.

MALTA - il-Bahrija area: several places including ta' Sarena, valleybed between il-Qliegħi and tat-Tulliera, Wied il-Mielah (8-1992) - il-Fiddien, Wied il-Qlejgħ / Chadwick lakes valley system (1992) - Wied tal-Ğnejna / Wied taċ-Ċerċura (1992) - Wied Gerżuma (1992) - Wied il-Hmar (vicinity of Tas-Santi) (27-8-1996) - Wied ta' l-Isqof (1992) - Wied il-Kbir (23-5-2008) (flourished in a pool of run-off from a recently opened mushroom farm) - Wied il-Luq, Wied tal-Għirġenti valley system (1992).

GOZO - Hondoq ir-Rummien area: ta' Għaroba (1997) - l-Imġarr area: il-Ġnien (early 1990's) - Wied il-Ğasri (30-9-2000) - Wied ta' San Blas (early 1990's).

Family: *Orobanchaceae*

79. *Orobanche cernua* Loefling

MALTA - Marsascala: coastline along Triq is-Salini (2003) - rocks opposite St.Paul's Islands (1) (early 1990's).

GOZO - Marsalforn area: il-Mielha (4-6-2008) - il-Munxar area: Sanap cliffs (5-3-2008) - ta' Rdum (opposite il-GeVha tal-Halfa) (12-4-2008).

COMINO - l-Ğhamieri peninsula (early 1990's).

80. *Orobanche densiflora* Salzmann f. *melitensis* Beck

MALTA - l-Aħrax tal-Mellieħha area: il-Ponta tal-Bir, ta' Tutti, it-Torri tal-Qortin it-Twil, ta' Makka, l-Ğhar tal-Ğhasafar, is-Sur ta' l-Aħrax, around it-Torri l-Abjad, il-Bieb tal-Ğhar, tax-Xmajar, between l-Aħrax tar-Ramal and il-Wied tar-Ratal, tax-Xilep, Rdum il-Ġriewi (early 1990's) - il-Mellieħha area: Ġnien Ingraw (2001); il-Ħalqun ta' San Diklaw (2001); ir-Ramla tal-Mellieħha (early 1990's); rocks around it-Tunnara museum (4-2007); Wied tal-Madonna (18-9-2006) - between il-Mistra bay and rocks facing St. Paul's Islands (1) (12-3-2003) - Qalet Marku peninsula (29-4-1993) - Wied il-Ğħasel area: between il-Knisja tal-Ğhar and turning point to Misraħ Ghonoq (1) (4-2002).

81. *Orobanche hederae* Duby

MALTA - abundant at San Anton Gardens (early 1990's) - Wied Harq Hamiem (1) (1995) (shown to the author by Darrin Stevens).

82. *Orobanche lavandulacea* Reichenbach (P.1)

MALTA - Dingli cliffs area: il-Wardija (16-6-2008) - boulder screes on clay slopes overlooking ir-Ramla ta' Ghajnejha (5-4-2008) - Ras il-Pellegrin (7-4-2008).

Family: *Plantaginaceae*

83. *Plantago major* L.

MALTA - l-Argotti Botanic Gardens (1992) - il-Baħrija area: several places including valleybed between tat-Tulliera and il-Qliegħi, tas-Sarena (8-1992)* - il-Fiddien (c.2001) - Ĝebel id-Dwejra olive grove (late 1990's) - Ģnien il-Kbir (1992) - Ghajnejha area: il-Ġnien, around Roman baths, il-Wied tal-Ġinna (13-2-1995) - l-Imtaħleb area: Wied ta' Markozz, along road leading to ta' Pajpurijiet (1992) Rdum tas-Sargħ, Rdum tal-Vigarju, Wied ta' ġordajna (1995) - il-Mellieħha area: Ghajnejha Hadid (14-3-2000) - l-Imtarfa area: Santa Lucija (16-1-2002) - ir-Rabat: it-Telgħa tas-Saqqajja (1) (c.2004)* - San Ġiljan: it-Telgħa ta' San Ġiljan (1) (4-2007) - San Martin (7-1992) - Valletta: Royal Opera House ruin (1) (1992)* - Wied tal-ġnejna: il-Ġnien (1992) - Wied Geržuma (1992)* - Wied il-Luq (1992) - Wied Qirda (1992).

GOZO - Daħlet Qorrot (2-1993)* - San Blas, Rdum il-Kbir area (1993) - Wied tal-Lunżjata, Fontana (including 1-Għajnejha il-Kbira), Wied tax-Xlendi / Wied ta' l-Ilma valley system (29-7-1994)* - Wied ir-Riħan (24-4-2003).

Was increasing until the 1990's, maybe due it being a nitrophilic species. Now seems to be diminishing, due to intensive modification of valleybeds by agricultural development.

84. *Plantago bellardi* Allioni (P.1)

MALTA - l-Aħrax tal-Mellieħha area: il-Madonna ta' l-Aħrax (19-4-2008); tax-Xilep, Rdum il-Grīewi (7-6-2008).

Family: *Asteraceae*

85. *Anacylus tomentosus* (Allioni) DC.

MALTA - h'Attard area: ta' Ċampra, ta' Irmiedi (fields between Wied il-Hemsija, Wied ta' Ċampra, Wied ta' l-Irmiedi valley system and Triq l-Imdina highway) (17-5-2008) - ta' Qali national park (17-5-2008) - San Pawl il-Baħar area: in a *Eucalyptus* grove outside is-Simar nature reserve (2004); Telghet ix-Xemxija (22-5-2008).

May not be indigenous. Found in open grassy places that have been subject to much leveling by human development.

86. *Anthemis arvensis* L.

MALTA - Laroka plateau (overlooking il-Buskett) (early 1990's) - Pieta pinetum (c.2003) - Wied Qirda (late 1990's) - Wied iż-Żurrieq area: along a pathway between il-Wied tal-Majla and ix-Xaghra ta' Smith / ix-Xaghra ta' Ras il-Bajjada (2005).

Past literature records this species as " Malta e Gozo, commune ! "(Sommier & Caruana Gatto 1915) " common "(Haslam et al. 1977) and was still frequent until the 1960's (E. Lanfranco pers.com.). Seems to have declined dramatically.

87. *Atractylis cancellata* L. (P.1)

88. *Carlina lanata* L.

This species is recorded in past literature as “ common ” (Haslam et al. 1977) and was still frequent until the 1970's (E. Lanfranco & M. Briffa pers.com). Seems to have declined dramatically. Partial to clay soils.

89. *Catananche lutea* L. (P.1)

MALTA - ta' Glidi (between Haġar Qim, l-Imnajdra temples and it-Torri tal-Hamrija) (14-2-2008) - l-Aħrax tal-Mellieħa area: il-Qatgħa ta' Plegg (12-3-2008).

90. *Crupina crupinastrum* (Moris) Visiani

MALTA - l-Argentier (plateau overlooking il-Ballut tal-Wardija and San Martin) (22-5-2008) - il-Manikata area: ix-Xagħra l-Hamra (13-7-2007) - il-Mellieħa area: Ġnien Ingraw; Ghajn Żejtuna (21-1-2008); l-Imġiebaħ (6-2002); karstlands aound il-Prajiet / Popeye Village (2002); rocky terraces along it-Telgħa ta' Selmun (c. 2000); around it-Torri l-Ahmar (13-6-2003); Wied Hanżira (2002) - il-Mižieb ridge: karstland stretches between il-Mižieb woodland and il-Manikata, including ix-Xagħra ta' Rassa (22-3-2003); between ix-Xemxija heights and il-Mižieb woodland (26-4-2005); around Xemxija Civil Protection Unit enclosure (22-4-2005) - Pembroke (22-6-2003) - ta' Pijru, ta' Žejsi / tal-Malaċin (humps of rock on the outskirts of il-Mosta, along Triq Xifer il-Kief) (13-4-2002) - Wied id-Dis (5-4-2000) - karstland stretches between Wied Rini and Pupiruwa (10-4-2002) - Wied Mejxu (1995) - ix-Xagħra tat-Tombu (near l-Imselliet school) (13-4-2002) - iż-Żebbieħ (13-4-2002).

GOZO - ix-Xewkija area: ix-Xagħra tal-Kus (4-5-2003).

Frequent among garrigue and steppic vegetation in the Northern half of the island of Malta; virtually absent elsewhere.

91. *Geropogon hybridus* (L.) Schultz Bip.

92. *Hyoseris frutescens* Brullo & Pavone

MALTA - Dingli cliffs area: on a rock on which is built a rectangular *ħitan tas-sejjieħ* hut at il-Wardija (1995) - Marfa peninsula: coastal rock boulders below Ghajn Tuta (26-5-2008).

H. frutescens is common in Gozo; hence no Gozo records are given.

93. *Onopordum argolicum* Boissier (P.1)

MALTA - Dingli cliffs area: it-Turretta (9-6-2008).

94. *Podospermum resedifolium* (L.) DC.

MALTA - Ghajn Tuffieha area: il-Qarraba (2007) - Wied ta' Fomm ir-Riħ (7-4-2008).

GOZO - id-Dabrani hill flanks (25-1-2005) - ta' ġordan hill flanks (10-6-2008) - ta' Harrax hill flanks (25-1-2005) - ta' Leveċċa hillock (between iż-Żebbuġ and l-Għasri) (1996) - Marsalforn / ix-Xaghra area: il-Mielha, below Rdum ta' Kilulu (5-1994) - ix-Xaghra area: Taħt in-niċċa / ta' Fotier terraces (4-6-2008).

Frequent in Gozo; rare in Malta. Partial to clay soils.

95. *Scolymus grandiflorus* Desfontaines

MALTA - Wied Gerżuma (30-5-2008).

96. *Senecio pygmaeus* DC.

MALTA - Ghajn Tuffieha area: il-Qarraba (2007) - Marfa peninsula: among boulder screes between il-Minzel ta' Ruman / il-Minzel tar-Rixtellu and ta' Qassisu (vicinity of il-Qammieħ) (1-1993) - Qalet Marku (2-12-2000) - Rdum Majjiesa (5-2000).

GOZO - rocks facing il-GeVla tal-Halfa (27-1-2008) - ir-Ramla l-Hamra area: clays below l-Irdum tal-Marin (9-4-2008).

COMINO - l-Għemieri peninsula (early 1990's).

Family: *Alismataceae*

97. *Alisma plantago-aquatica* L.

Literature regarding this species has recorded it as a coastal rock plant (eg. Brullo, Lanfranco & Pavone 1982; Lanfranco 1989). However it is also found inland, as in the following localities, where it grows in abundance:

103. *Allium nigrum* L.

121. *Crypsis schoenoides* (L.) Lamarck

GOZO - id-Dwejra area: valleybed between il-Qattara and il-Qawra / Inland Sea (c.1000) (7-1993) (During a site visit in 2007, accompanied by Mr. Joe Sultana, only 4 stunted specimens were found. A photograph of one specimen appeared in the popular publication Nature in Gozo).
