





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




EDITORIAL ...

Important!!! - Please read carefully

Your attention is drawn to the provision of Standing Orders regulating the election of the Executive Committee as amended during the AGM held on the 30th April, 1998.

1b. The Election of members to the Executive Committee or to any other post, shall be held one hour from the commencement of the Annual General Meeting or of any Extraordinary General Meeting. All items on the Agenda will be suspended for the duration of the voting and until the three tellers proposed by the meeting will be satisfied that an election result is obtained.

16. ELECTIONS

16 i Three tellers shall be nominated, seconded and approved by the members present during the Meeting.

16 ii Ballot papers, besides the heading, instructions, official stamp and the signature of at least two tellers, will only contain the list of all candidates in alphabetical order. (continued on next page)

16 iii The tellers shall explain the voting instructions verbally.

16 iv Members will only be allowed to vote **on presentation of their membership card** which will be exchanged for one ballot paper by the tellers and temporarily retained. The membership card will be returned when the ballot paper is handed back to the teller,

16 v If a member invalidates a ballot paper during voting, the member may ask the teller to replace the ballot paper. The tellers will immediately cancel the invalidated ballot paper, marked accordingly and retained.


16 vi Any member arriving for the meeting before the tellers start collecting the ballot papers, is entitled to vote.

16 vii After voting, the tellers shall collect the ballot papers, check their validity and declare the number of valid votes.

16 viii The tellers shall count the votes in private

16 ix In case of a tie between two or more candidates for a place/s on the Executive Committee, procedures iii, iv, v, vi, and vii above, will be repeated until a complete election result is obtained.

Marthese Cassar

"Photography gives me the opportunity to be more observant and sensitive to the environment that surrounds me".

This is, more or less, what prompted Marthese to take up photography as an art form. Backed by her love for nature and landscapes, she tries to capture anything that catches her eye and experiments with different points of view and techniques. Marthese always loved carrying a camera around but when, some eight years ago, she had the opportunity to travel more frequently, her priority item on her "pack" list, was always her camera. At that point in time, she still considered photos as the best souvenir one can end up with on return from abroad. However, since joining the Malta Photographic Society three years ago, her concept of photography became more serious.

Her attendance for the Society's popular "Starting Photography" Course resulted in her winning the Best Assignment Award and her appreciation of photography from a more artistic view. This was her turning point in her photography. She invested in her first SLR camera and started to participate regularly in the Society's monthly competitions.

Five years ago she was engulfed in the Digital revolution and started to explore the infinite tools of Photoshop Nowadays, her equipment consists of a Canon 400D SLR, Tamron Zoom Lens $28\,\text{mm} - 200\,\text{mm}$; and a Canon $2.8\,100\,\text{mm}$ macro lens.

Marthese contends that digital photography has encouraged her to take photography more seriously. One particular advantage for her is the fact that one can view the image a split second after it is made and proceed to "doctor" it on one's PC before printing it in a Professional lab.

Her preference between colour and monochrome is more for the former, depending on the subject. So she tries to do both. Marthese does her best to learn from the analysis of her work during the monthly competitions as well as observing other members' work. Her immediate plans are to improve her Macro photography mostly that of Maltese flora and fauna.

Marthese is the current Hon. Secretary of the Society.



NADINE GENOVESE

Nadine's love for the theatre was born when her drama teacher asked her to do an impromptu audition and she was roped in a school production.

In 2001 she was taking French lessons at the Alliance Francaise in Floriana. One particular course was "Learning French through Drama". Nadine thought it would be a good opportunity to improve her spoken French and decided to sign up. This saw the birth of theatre@lliance. Following no less than five productions, the Director decided to set up a theatre company, the current "Theatrencore"

Since then, two full scale productions were produced, the first called "Shadows of the Gods", depicting the life of St Therese of Liseaux followed by "In Search of Simone", the life and works of French philosopher Simon de Beauvoir. As a photographer in her own right, Nadine is looking forward to the company's forthcoming production on the

life of Henri Cartier Bresson, considered to be the father of modern photojournalism.



Nadine's contribution to the theatre company goes beyond that of an actress. She is also responsible for the procurement of the property of the productions. The acting side of her talent is a continuous learning process. According to her, acting on stage is not just learning the lines by heart but more that of portraying the right emotions and characteristics of the character one is interpreting. Preparations for a performance normally start two months before, with rehearsals and workshops with a gradual increase in the frequency of these activities ending up with daily meetings. Nadine's satisfaction and that of all actors is the

applause and reactions of the audience to particular lines and situations as well as the feedback of stage critics (not always positive). Yet, she says, it still makes it so worthwhile.

SIR ANTHONY MAMO Q.C., O.B.E., B.A., LL.D. CHIEF JUSTICE, GOVERNOR- GENERAL & FIRST PRESIDENT OF THE REPUBLIC PATRON OF THE MALTA PHOTOGRAPHIC SOCIETY

Born in Birkirkara on the 8th January, 1909 and passed away on the 1st May, 2008, eight months short of his 100th Birthday.

He lived through an illustrious professional career ending up as Chief Justice and President of the Court of Appeal. In 1964 he became the first President of the Constitutional Court and in 1967 he was appointed the first President of the Court of Criminal Appeals. In 1971 he became governor-general, the first and only Maltese to hold that post. In 1974 he was elected as the first President of the Maltese Republic.

Awarded the highest honours bestowed by our country, he was also the recipient of the O.B.E. and also appointed Honorary Queen's Counsel.

14th FIAP NATURE BIENNIAL – SPAIN

The Confederacion Espanola de Fotografia invites all National Societies affiliated to FIAP to participate in the 14th FIAP Nature Biennial which will take place in Palma de Mallorca from the 31st August to the 22nd December 2008.

Two Sections; PRINTS (black & white and/or colour) & PROJECTED IMAGES (Slides or Files). Each Association may enter 10 prints in B & W and/or Colour (1 print per author) & 20 Projected Images 2 per author). Each collection must be **coherent** from the point of view of **inspiration & conception** as well as from **realization and presentation**. Prints have to be in format 30x40cms. Smaller prints must be mounted on a light support 30x40cms (12"x16"), Slides must be **Glass Mounted** and of 5x5cm format (2"x2") only. Files must be JPG 10, 300dpi, 2400 pixels in the longer side.
