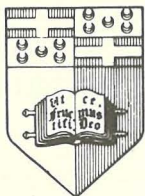
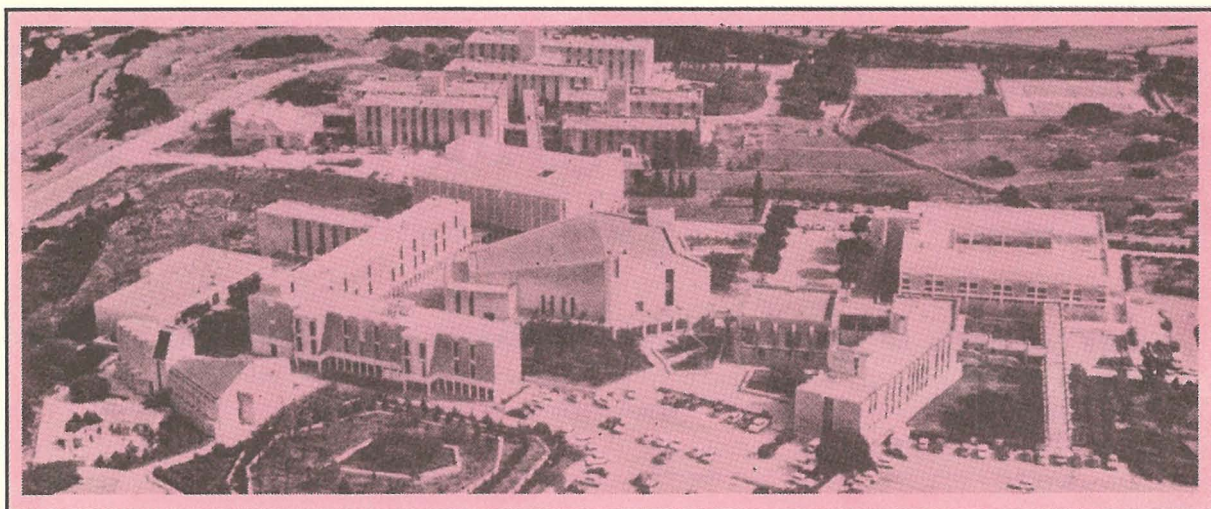

## EVENING DIPLOMA COURSES

### *Business Law and Accounting*

More than one hundred and fifty students are attending the Evening Diploma Course in Business Law and Accounting, which commenced in February.

The aim of this Course is to provide participants with a foundation in law and accounting for a range of careers in commerce and industry, financial institutions and public service.

## COURSE IN MANAGEMENT FOR MALTA DRYDOCKS MANAGERS AND WORKS COMMITTEE MEMBERS

The Faculty of Management Studies and the Workers' Participation Development Centre (WPDC) of the University are organising a three-month course for Drydocks managers and Works Committee members in the period between February and May 1986. This course is being held at the invitation of the Council and Management of the Malta Drydocks.

The main purpose of this course is to provide the participants with an opportunity for a re-appraisal of their own managerial roles and expertise in the execution of duties and responsibilities. The course is divided into three parts. The first part dealing with social-psychological issues aims to help the participants cope better with the complex problems of human interrelations inherent in a large participatory firm. The second part comprises Economic Issues of Management and aims to enhance the participants' ability to cope with the essential competitive economic environment by expounding to them the right tools of analysis. The third part deals with Issues of Financial Control and provides the participants with an up-to-date scientific and professional approach to decision making and financial control.
