

#### FULBRIGHT PROFESSORS AT THE UNIVERSITY

On Thursday, 24th March 1988, the United States Ambassador Mr. Peter Sommer presented three hundred books on Management and other related studies to the Faculty of Management and Business Studies.

The books came mainly from the private collection of Professor H. Tewari, who was attached to the University through the Fulbright Programme. Others were donated by his home University in Dayton, Ohio.

The books were presented to the Rector, Rev. Professor Peter Serracino Inglott and to the Chairman of the Faculty, Professor Reno Borg.

Several American professors attached to the University over the past twenty years have sought to keep alive the links between Malta and the United States.

The American Ambassador said that Professor W. Berg, the first American Professor attached to the University twenty years ago, will be coming back next September to serve at the University for yet another year.

Most professors coming to Malta through the Fulbright Programme came from the fields of management and business. This was relevant to Malta in its quest to strive towards full development.

The Ambassador added that two professors will be teaching at the University through this programme next year. These were to serve in the Faculties of Business Management and of Medicine.

Also attending the presentation were Ms. Yolande Veron-Sullivan, Director of the American Centre in Malta, which administers the Fulbright Programme locally and Mr. L. Ellul, Registrar of the University.

#### FOUNDATION PROGRAMME OF STUDIES IN DIPLOMACY

The University of Malta, in cooperation with the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, has organised a three-month Foundation Programme of Studies in Diplomacy, which commenced on the 29th February, 1988.

The Programme consists of lectures in three areas of study: International Law, International Relations, and International Trade and Finance.

#### STUDENT EXCHANGE PROGRAMMES

The prospects for more student exchanges at university level were discussed during a recent visit to Malta by Ms Maryanne Grant, the Executive Director of the U.S. International Student Exchange Program (ISEP). ISEP, a private non-profit organization promoting student exchanges, is administered by Georgetown University.

This visit followed the participation in ISEP Conferences held in Plymouth, England and Williamsburg, Virginia, USA, by Mrs A. Tabone, the University of Malta ISEP Coordinator.

Ms Maryanne Grant has had discussions with officials of the University and met Maltese and American students participating in the programme. Furthermore, she had the opportunity of calling on U.S.I.A. officials and on the American Ambassador, Mr Peter R. Sommer.

Over two hundred colleges and universities in 35 countries around the world are currently members of the organization. The University of Malta joined ISEP in 1983 during a U.S.I.A. sponsored visit by Dr D. Fenech.

About fifty Maltese students have studied for a semester at various ISEP member universities and an equivalent number of American students have studied at the University for a semester. The exchanges have been in all disciplines of study including education, engineering, history, law, management studies, pharmacy, and computer science.

#### AMERICAN WEEK AT THE UNIVERSITY

A programme of activities was organized to coincide with American Week, which was held at the University Assembly Hall in the period Friday 19th to Friday 26th February.

Activities included films, a slide presentation, seminars, one-act plays and a jazz concert.

Throughout the week, the 'Tamarind Impressions' exhibition of contemporary American lithographs from the Tamarind Institute was open to the public.

Moreover, as part of the activities organized by the Post-Graduate Medical Committee, David A. Newsome, Professor of Retinal Degenerations at Louisiana State University Eye Centre, New Orleans, U.S.A., was invited to deliver two lectures at the Medical School.

On Thursday, 3rd March he delivered a lecture on 'The Management of High Degenerative Myopia', while on the following day he spoke on 'The Management of Diabetic Retinopathy and other Retinal Degenerations'. During the lectures, Professor Newsome showed videos on the newest technology being used to combat poor vision and severe refractive problems in the United States.

He also visited eye patients at the Out-Patient Clinic at St. Luke's Hospital and had talks with the Hon. Dr. J. Rizzo Naudi, Parliamentary Secretary for the Aged, in his capacity as Chairman of the Post-Graduate Medical Committee.

#### SYMPOSIUM AND PHARMACEUTICAL EXHIBITION

In the period 11th to 13th March, 1988, the Department of Pharmacy organized a Symposium and a Pharmaceutical Exhibition.

The activities, which began with a commemoration to the memory of Mr. A.M. Darmenia Ph.C., M.R.S.H., was opened by the Hon. Dr. L. Galea, Minister of Social Policy.

Professor P.F. D'Arcy delivered a lecture on 'Clinical Significance of Drug Interactions'.

The Symposium consisted of presentations of the projects submitted by B.Pharm. Final Year students.

A Pharmaceutical Exhibition by leading Drug Firms was held concurrently with the Symposium at University House.

#### SEMINAR ON THE CARE OF THE ELDERLY IN MALTA

On Thursday, 14th January, 1988, the Secretariat for the Care of the Elderly in co-operation with the Department of Applied Social Studies of the University organised a Seminar on the care of the elderly in Malta.

The aim of this Seminar was to examine and explore the problems and opportunities arising from an aging Maltese population. There was an exchange of views with Danish Social Workers attending the Seminar.

The Seminar was introduced by the Hon. John Rizzo Naudi, Parliamentary Secretary for the Care of the Elderly. Miss Mariosa Cassar spoke on 'The Elderly in Malta: Demographic Set-Up' while Dr. Mario Vassallo, Acting Head of the Department of Applied Social Studies, chaired a forum on 'The Provision of Services for the Elderly in Malta'.

#### SEMINAR ON REVERSE OSMOSIS MEMBRANE TECHNOLOGY

In the period 17th to 19th February, 1988, the University of Malta and the Water Works Department held a seminar on 'Reverse Osmosis Membrane Technology in Desalination Plants'.

Participants included Reverse Osmosis Plant Engineers, Managers, Technologists, Industrialists responsible for the Procurement, Installation, Operation and Maintenance of Reverse Osmosis Plants.

#### THE LATE PROFESSOR ANDREW VELLA O.P.

The following appreciation has been written by Ms. Ann Williams, M.A., B.Litt.(Oxon.), Senior Lecturer in Mediterranean History, University of Aberdeen:

'I have just heard with great sorrow of the death of my former colleague and Head of Department in the University of Malta, Professor Andrew Vella O.P.

His guidance of the History Department in the University, at the time of expansion in the sixties, was committed and enthusiastic. His concern for his students and his staff was total. His pioneer work on Maltese History covered a wide range of subjects and was crowned by his *Storja ta' Malta*.

My sadness at the long illness of his later years, and at his death, will be lightened by the memory of his laughter, his good fellowship and his generosity of spirit in better times.'

#### THE LATE GUZÈ CARDONA B.A.(HONS.), M.A.

Professor J. Aquilina B.A., LL.D., Ph.D.(Lond.), former Professor and Head of Department of Maltese, writing in the issue of *The Sunday Times*, dated 21st February, 1988, paid this tribute:

'As one grows older one experiences the pain of departure from this planet of friends who suddenly disappear from the world of the living. In terms of fugitive time one realises how truly ephemeral human existence is when one notices the endless succession of such painful disappearances.

I have just heard of the sudden death of my friend and, at one time, my student, Guzè Cardona, the author of Dun Karm's biography (his M.A. thesis) and of the novel *Manwel Gellel* (1960). I first knew Cardona as one of my university students and later as a helper and part-time lecturer in the Department of Maltese.

He was a dedicated teacher with a long pedagogic career as instructor in government primary schools (1948-1959), in secondary schools (1959-1966), in the University (1968-1976) and in the Teachers' Training College at Tal-Virtù and Ta' Giorni (1968-1974). In 1976 he was selected as one of the Heads of the Department of Maltese in the secondary schools.

This brief outline of his pedagogic career shows Cardona as primarily a teacher to the very end of his life. In retirement he devoted some of his time to translations, the last work in hand being the biography of Sister Paola Frassinetti, the Foundress of the Congregation of the Sisters of St. Dorothy.

I've been told he nearly finished his biography of Mgr. Sidor Formosa, Founder of the Ursuline Sisters. And he also collected considerable material on the life of Dun Alfred Gatt in the hope that he would also be able to write his biography and contribute to the Cause of his Beatification. He had a deep sense of religion that gives recognisable purpose to human life. Indeed religion and the Maltese language were the two beacon-lights of his life.

As friends disappear all that survivors can do is to pray for the repose of their friends who departed this life to continue living in their new and final homeland, God's Kingdom in Heaven.'
