Connecting Research and Researchers

#### What is an ORCID iD?

An ORCID iD is a permanent identifier – a 16 digit number, that distinguishes you from other researchers. It connects you with your research publications and professional activities.

## Why should you have an ORCID iD?

- 1. An ORCID iD prevents confusion about author names and ensures you will get credit for you work. This benefits your visibility.
  - 2. ORCID iD is becoming an international standard various publishers and funders require an ORCID iD when submitting manuscripts, articles and/or grant applications.
  - 3. You can easily save your publications list as BibTeX file which can be imported to your RefWorks.

### How could you get an ORCID iD?

Go to the ORCID iD registration page and fill in the requested details. You will receive a 16 digit number, i.e. your ORCID iD.
