Do you have your ORCID iD?



What is an ORCID iD?

An ORCID iD is a permanent identifier – a 16 digit number, that distinguishes you from other researchers. It connects you with your research publications and professional activities.

Why should you have an ORCID iD?

1. An ORCID iD prevents confusion about author names and ensures you will get credit for your work. This benefits your visibility.
2. ORCID iD is becoming an international standard - various publishers and funders require an ORCID iD when submitting manuscripts, articles and/or grant applications.
3. You can easily save your publications list as BibTeX file which can be imported to your RefWorks.

How could you get an ORCID iD?

Go to the ORCID iD registration page and fill in the requested details. You will receive a 16 digit number, i.e. your ORCID iD.
