TWO SUSPECTS DETAINED IN HAMRUN BOMB OUTRAGE

Italian Ousted From Malta University

MALTA, Jan. 4.

The Governor has issued a proclamation giving effect to the Ordinance whereby certain subjects thereto taught in Italian in the university of Malta will in future be taught in English.

CIVIL LORD OF ADMIRALTY ARRIVES IN MALTA

REVENGE A MOTIVE

At about 3.25 yesterday morning a loud explosion took place in Strada Reale, Hanoï, where Micallef, who is a contractor and the proprietor of the Plymouth Mining Waterbury was awakened and, thinking that it was a car smash, appeared to investigate. He found that the front door, No. 413, had been partly blown in.

The police immediately called the station and report the accident. The police arrived at the station and conducted a minor investigation. It was found that the car had been smashed by a large stone and pieces of metal had been scattered in walls and doors on the street. Fortunately, no one was hurt.

The police have rounded up suspects and are pursuing their investigation.

Mr. Michael Mirabet, who was interviewed by our reporter, said it was quite possible that the charge had been perpetrated by the initiators of his as he has never been successful in securing a conviction by tender.

Madankollu l-eżitu ta' dan il-każ mhux magħruf minħabba li dwaru ftit li xejn kien rappurtat aktar fil-ġurnali ta' dak iż-żmien.
