European white clay bowl fragment. The moulded seam has a raised decoration resembling 'a ships mast with very small sails.'

According to archaeologist Dr Peter Hammond (Society for Clay Pipe Research) "The masted ship is a common design – a pity it is so fragmentary – but could easily be English or Scottish, late 19th century."
