Triq S Martin VCT1883 5U109 (over 106) GD 2014 01/08/14 Pipa tal-qasba from a recent excavation at Triq S Martin, VCT 1883, Gozo.

A terracotta clay artefact consisting rim, bowl and the fore part of a keel. The shank end is missing, the rim chipped. The bowl has gadroon decoration and the rim is slightly faceted in eight planes. The front five planes have 14-petal flower heads impressed around the edges to make a raised impression. 18th-19th century.
