The book is well-structured except for the final part; although the appendices contain information that is very interesting for a study of medieval Malta, only one (Analysis of an Arch in the Annunciation Church) of them should have appeared in a book that purports to be a report of the excavations carried out at Hal Millieri. This is all the more so when one considers that the authors of the other appendices do not integrate their views with the results of the Hal Millieri excavations.

The campaign of 1977 at Hal Millieri has produced very in-teresting results. Two contiguous medieval churches were investigated: the church of the Annunciation and the remains of the church of the Visitation, the southern wall of which was in fact the greater part of the north-ern wall of the former church, which was longer.

The church of the Annunciation can be dated to the 15th century on the basis of six coins which belong to the period 1402-1479 and which were found in a securely stratified context, namely in the make-up of the floor of this church. Excavation revealed that this church stood over an earlier one, which cannot be securely dated; however, it seems to stem from some time between the 13th and the late 15th century.
