# EDUCATION ACT (CAP. 327)

## Bye-Laws of 2017 in terms of the General Regulations for University Undergraduate Awards, 2004 for the Diploma in Aviation Maintenance under the auspices of the Institute of Aerospace Technologies

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon him by articles 74 (5) and 75 (6) of the Education Act (Cap. 327), the Chancellor of the University of Malta has promulgated the following bye-laws made by the Board of the Institute of Aerospace Technologies in virtue of the powers conferred upon it by article 8(b)(v) of the Statute for the Institute, which bye-laws have been approved by the Senate of the University of Malta:

#### **Citation and Interpretation**

- 1. (1) These bye-laws may be cited as the Bye-Laws of 2017 in terms of the General Regulations for University Undergraduate Awards, 2004 for the Diploma in Aviation Maintenance under the auspices of the Institute of Aerospace Technologies.
  - (2) In these bye-laws, unless the context otherwise requires -

"the Board" means the Board of the Institute of Aerospace Technologies;

"the Certificate" means the Certificate in Aviation Maintenance;

"the Course" means the programme of study leading to the Diploma in Aviation Maintenance; and

"the Diploma" means the Diploma in Aviation Maintenance.

#### **Applicability**

2. These bye-laws shall be applicable for courses commencing in October 2017 or later.

#### **Requirements for Admission**

- 3. (1) To be registered as regular students in the Course, applicants shall, apart from satisfying the general requirements for admission as specified in the Admissions Regulations, be in possession of:
- (a) passes at Advanced Matriculation Level at Grade C or better in Physics and one other subject; or
  - (b) the EASA Part 66 License or equivalent; or
  - (c) a technical diploma (such as HND/HTD) or equivalent.

### Applicable for courses commencing in October 2019 or later:

- 3. (1) To be registered as regular students in the Course, applicants shall, apart from satisfying the general requirements for admission as specified in the Admissions Regulations, be in possession of:
- (a) a pass at Advanced Matriculation Level at Grade C or better in Physics, and a pass at Advanced Matriculation Level in one other subject; or
  - (b) the EASA Part 66 License or equivalent; or
  - (c) a technical diploma (such as HND/HTD) or equivalent.
- (2) If applicants have other qualifications considered to be sufficient, they may be exempted by the University Admissions Board, on the advice of the Institute Admissions Committee, from the whole or part of these special course requirements for admission.
- (3) Admission to the Course may, with the approval of Senate, be restricted to applicants who are nominated by an organisation that commissions the Course, provided that such applicants are eligible for admission in terms of paragraphs (1) and (2) of this bye-law. Such restriction shall be announced at the time of the call for applications.

#### **Course Duration**

4. The Course shall extend over a period of four semesters of part-time study and two summer periods.

#### **Course Programme**

5. (1) The Course shall comprise taught study-units to which a total of 60 ECTS credits shall be assigned.

- (2) Students who successfully complete a prescribed set of study-units totalling 30 ECTS credits with an average mark of at least 50% and do not proceed with the Course, or having proceeded do not successfully complete the Course, shall be entitled to the Certificate.
- 6. The programme of study shall be published after approval by Senate, normally not less than eight months prior to the commencement of the Course.

#### **Classification of the Awards**

- 7. (1) The overall evaluation of each student's performance in the Course for the purpose of the classification of the Diploma shall be based on the results obtained, all credits awarded being weighted equally.
- (2) The names of students who qualify for the award of the Diploma shall be published in a list in alphabetical order classified as follows:

Pass with Distinction Pass with Merit Pass.

(3) The Certificate shall be awarded unclassified.
