## SENATE RESOLUTION REGARDING CERTIFICATE COURSES APPLICABLE FROM OCTOBER 1998

- 1. Certificate courses are to be divided into two types:
  - University Undergraduate Certificate Courses; and
  - Faculty Certificate Courses.
- 2. University Undergraduate Certificate Courses:
- Admission Requirements: General Entry Requirements or professional qualifications
- Level: tertiary level
- **Duration:** one semester of full-time studies or equivalent
- Certification: certificate to be signed by the Dean/Director of the faculty/institute concerned and the Registrar
- 3. Faculty Certificate Courses:
- Admission Requirements: General Entry Requirements not necessarily required
- Level: pre-tertiary level
- **Duration:** one semester of full-time studies or equivalent
- **Certification:** certificate to be signed by the Dean/Director of the faculty/institute concerned and the Course Co-ordinator
- 4. (1) Regulations for the two types of certificate courses are to be approved by Senate and promulgated.
  - (2) All students are required to register for both types of courses in terms of the Admission Regulations.
