EDUCATION ACT CAP. 327

Statute 1 - General

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon him by articles 74(5) and 75(6) of the Education Act (Cap. 327), the Chancellor of the University of Malta has promulgated the following statute made by the Council of the University of Malta in virtue of the powers conferred upon it by articles 72, 75(1)(2), 77(d) and 136(3) of the said Act:

Citation

1. This statute may be cited as Statute 1 - General included in Schedule II of the Education Act (Cap.327).

1.1 Official Languages

Maltese and English shall be the official languages of the University. The University administration may use either language for official purposes.

1.2 Compulsory Subjects for Admission

Maltese and English shall be compulsory subjects for admission to the degree and diploma courses of the University:

Provided that the Senate may be regulations allow candidates in special circumstances to offer other subjects instead.

1.3 Entry Requirements: Period of Notice

The University shall give adequate notice (normally two years) before any amendments to regulations which may affect a candidate's preparation for admission to any course of studies (such as the requirement of a new subject in the Special Course Requirement) come into effect and two years notice for a change in a grade.

1.4 Official and Academic Dress

The dress appropriate for the Principal Officers of the University, for the Academic Staff, for graduates, for undergraduates, and for other members of the University shall be prescribed by regulations made by the Senate.

1.5 Scholarships and Prizes

- 1. Scholarships and prizes to be awarded by the University shall be established by regulations made for the purpose.
- 2. The award of scholarships and prizes shall also be governed by regulations.
