Layout: double line spacing
Legible font ex. Times New Roman

Margins: left – 3.5cm
Right – 2.5cm
Top – 2.5cm
Bottom – 2.5cm

Page nos: Centred (in main text)
Roman nos from first page to main text

Justified: left and right

Paragraph: no indentation

Quotations: single line spacing
Indented left and right
Justified left and right
Must include author name, date and page number referring to the parent text
Must be preceded and followed by a line space
