A. Introduction

Smart chapters are an automatic table of contents created through Optical Character Recognition (OCR), which identifies content within the video. All newly created content within Panopto now has smart chapters enabled by default. This feature is ideal to make navigation easier for viewers, in particular for lengthy recordings.

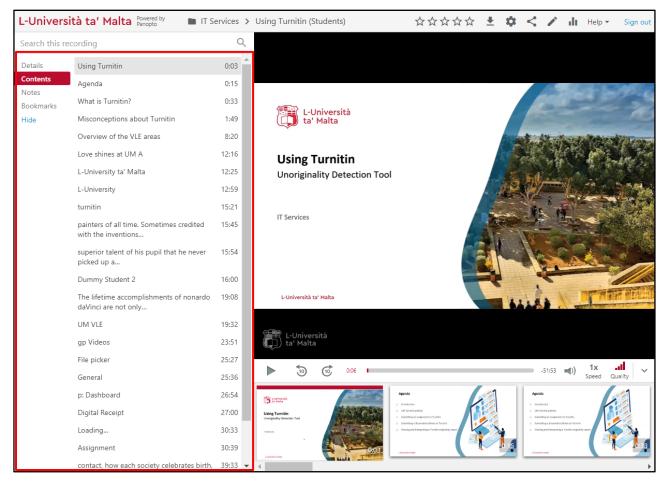
In this guide you will learn how to:

- View the auto-generated smart chapters
- **Review smart chapters**
 - Add a smart chapter entry
 - Modify a smart chapter entry
 - Delete a smart chapter entry

B. Viewing the auto-generated smart chapters

- 1. Access the UM Panopto platform.
- 2. Click the **Browse** button from the left menu.
- 3. Access the required folder. You may type in the study-unit code in the Search text field to immediately list the required study-unit's folder.
- 4. Click on the video thumbnail you would like to view.

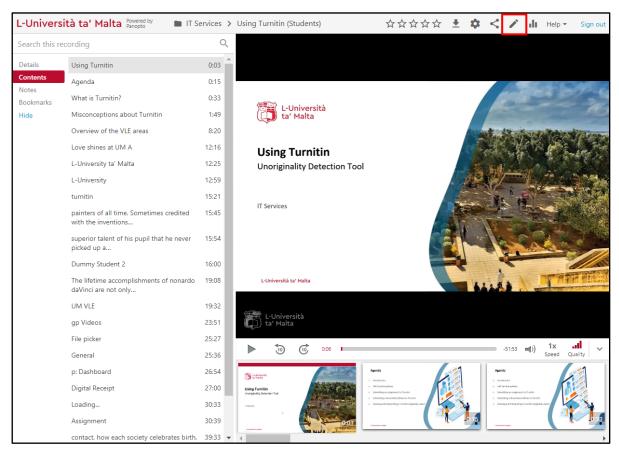
Smart Chapters will be displayed in the **Contents** section (on the left side of the screen).



C. Reviewing smart chapters

Even though smart chapters are automatically generated, corresponding to the content in the video, some smart chapters might not be as accurate. The tutor has the facility of adding, editing and deleting smart chapters.

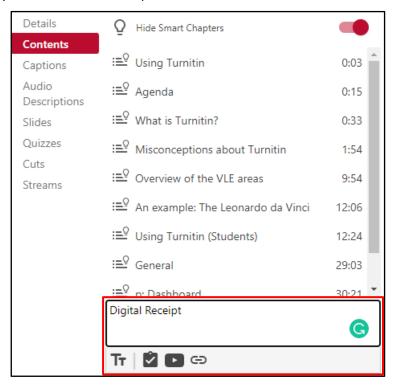
- 1. To review the smart chapters, access the required recording as instructed in Section B.
- 2. Click the **Edit** button (pencil icon) in the top-right corner.



You will be redirected to the Panopto video editing page where you can add, modify and delete smart chapters.

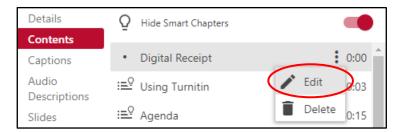
a. Adding smart chapters

- 1. To add smart chapters to an existing recording, access the editing window as instructed in
- 2. Insert the desired smart chapter name in the Enter a table of contents entry text box and press the **Enter** key to add the smart chapter.



The new smart chapter will be displayed either at the top or at the bottom of the current smart chapters list.

3. To amend the new entry's time, click More (3 dots) icon next to the smart chapter name and choose Edit.



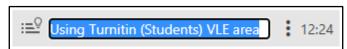
4. Change the **Time** of the new smart chapter entry, as desired.



- 5. Click Save.
- 6. Click **Apply** in the top-right corner to save the changes.

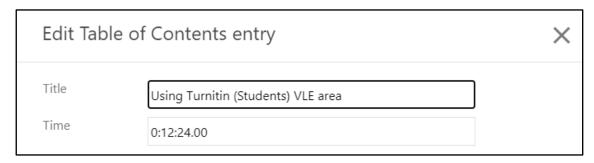
b. Modify Smart chapters

- 1. To modify smart chapters in an existing recording, access the editing window as instructed in Section C.
- 2. Click on the smart chapter entry you would like to modify. The current text is highlighted automatically.



3. Modify the text, as required and press the **Enter** key.

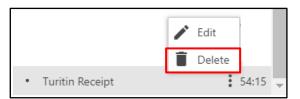
Alternatively, you may click the More (3 dots) icon next to the smart chapter name you would like to modify and click Edit. You can edit the Title and/or Time and then click Save to save your changes.



4. Click **Apply** in the top-right corner to save the changes.

c. Delete smart chapters

- 1. To delete smart chapters in an existing recording, access the editing window as instructed in Section C.
- 2. Click More (3 dots) icon next to the smart chapter name and click Delete.



The smart chapter entry will be deleted.

3. Click **Apply** in the top-right corner to save the changes.

Note:

- Smart Chapters might not be created for short recordings or recordings with little / no audio.
- Tutors who teach a language other than English can set the default content language to one of the 18 supported languages (Maltese language is not supported) by Panopto.
 - 1. Click on the Folder Settings button (gear icon) in the top right corner of your Panopto study-unit folder.
 - 2. Click on **Settings** from the left side menu.
 - 3. Choose the desired language from the **Content Language** drop-down menu.



- 4. Close the dialog window.
- Past recordings do not have smart chapters enabled automatically. You may enable them as follows:
 - 1. Access the editing window as instructed in Section C.
 - 2. Click on **Contents** from the left side menu.
 - 3. Click the **Show Smart Chapters** toggle button to enable smart chapters.



Automated smart chapters are created. You can add, modify and delete any of the entries.

4. Click **Apply** in the top-right corner to save the changes.
